

## Finding an Apartment



## Across

- **2.** The payment, usually monthly, that the tenant pays to the landlord.
- **4.** A legal document signed by both the tenant and the landlord that contains the terms of the agreement
- 7. A sum of money, usually equal to one month's rent, held by the landlord to cover any damage to the apartment caused by a tenant.
- **8.** The amount of time required in advance if either the landlord or the tenant wishes to discontinue the rental agreement. This courtesy allows both parties time to make other arrangements.
- **10.** The length of a rental agreement, usually a period of one year.

- **1.** Services needed to make a house or apartment functional, such as hot water, electricity, natural gas, and cable and Internet service.
- **3.** The company or individual who owns an apartment.
- **5.** One individual apartment. A large apartment building may contain 20 or more units.
