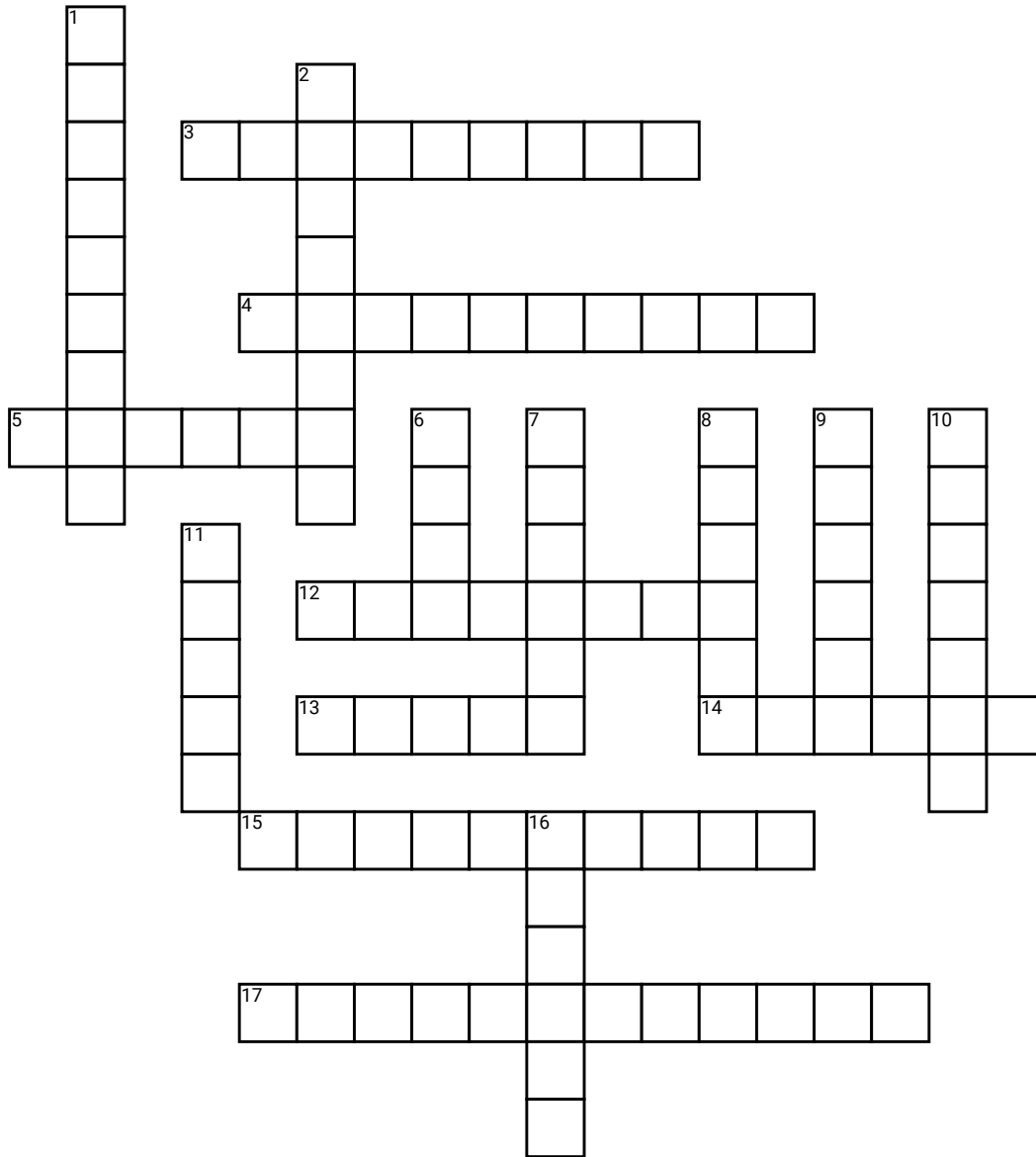

- 3.** \_\_\_\_\_ smoke is a smoke curtain used on the battlefield between threat observation points and friendly units to mask friendly forces, positions, and activities.
