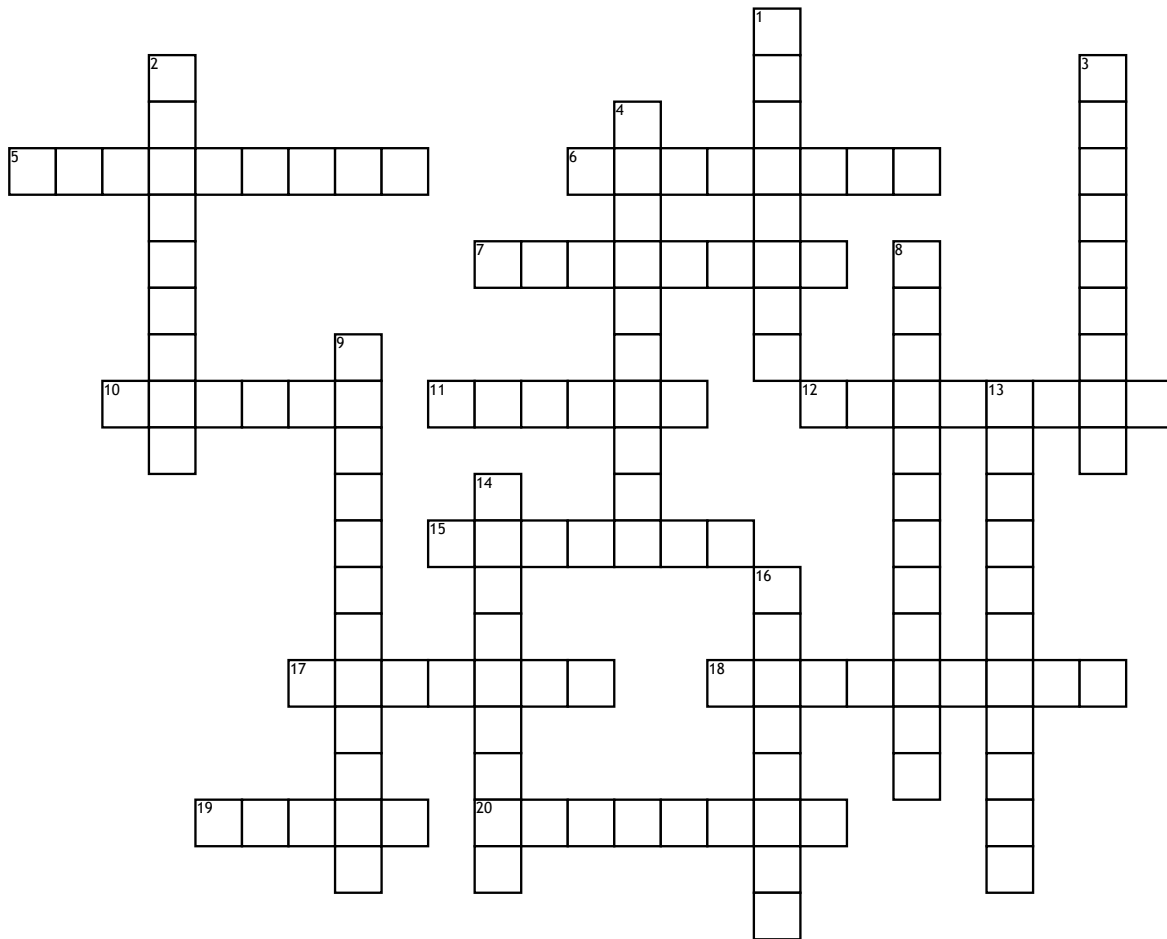


First and Foremost Vocab Crossword
