
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Flag Football

- 1. A forward pass that touches the ground before being caught
- 2. A defensive strategy in which more than one counter rushes in to pressure the QB
- **5.** The action in which the ball is thrown or handed to the QB or punter
- **12.** A scoring play where the football crosses the opponents goal line
- **14.** The act of throwing the ball to another player
- **15.** Team responsible for keeping opposition out of their end zone
- 17. An offensive player whose job is to catch the football
- **18.** A loss of possession of the ball
- 19. Typically the leader of the offense

- **20.** One try; you get 4 of these to be able to advance the ball down the field/into the end zone
- **21.** When the ball hits the ground as a result of a fumble, dropped handoff or snap, backwards pass or kickoff

- **9.** A ball that is "in play" while a play is in progress.
- **10.** A penalty that occurs when any part of a defender's body is beyond the line of scrimmage when the ball is snapped

- **13.** the team that has possession of the football and attempts to advance to the opponents goal line
