
Flower Reproduction



<u>Across</u>

- 2. the Male gamete
- 6. the reproduction of male and female gametes to produce a zygote
- 8. Produce male sex cells
- 9. Protect the unopened flower

- 10. produces female sex cells
- 11. the female gamete
- 12. May be brightly coloured to attract insects

<u>Down</u>

1. the transfer of pollen to a stigma, ovule, flower, or plant to allow fertilization.

- 3. The male part of the flower
- 4. The top part of the flower which is female and collects pollen grains
