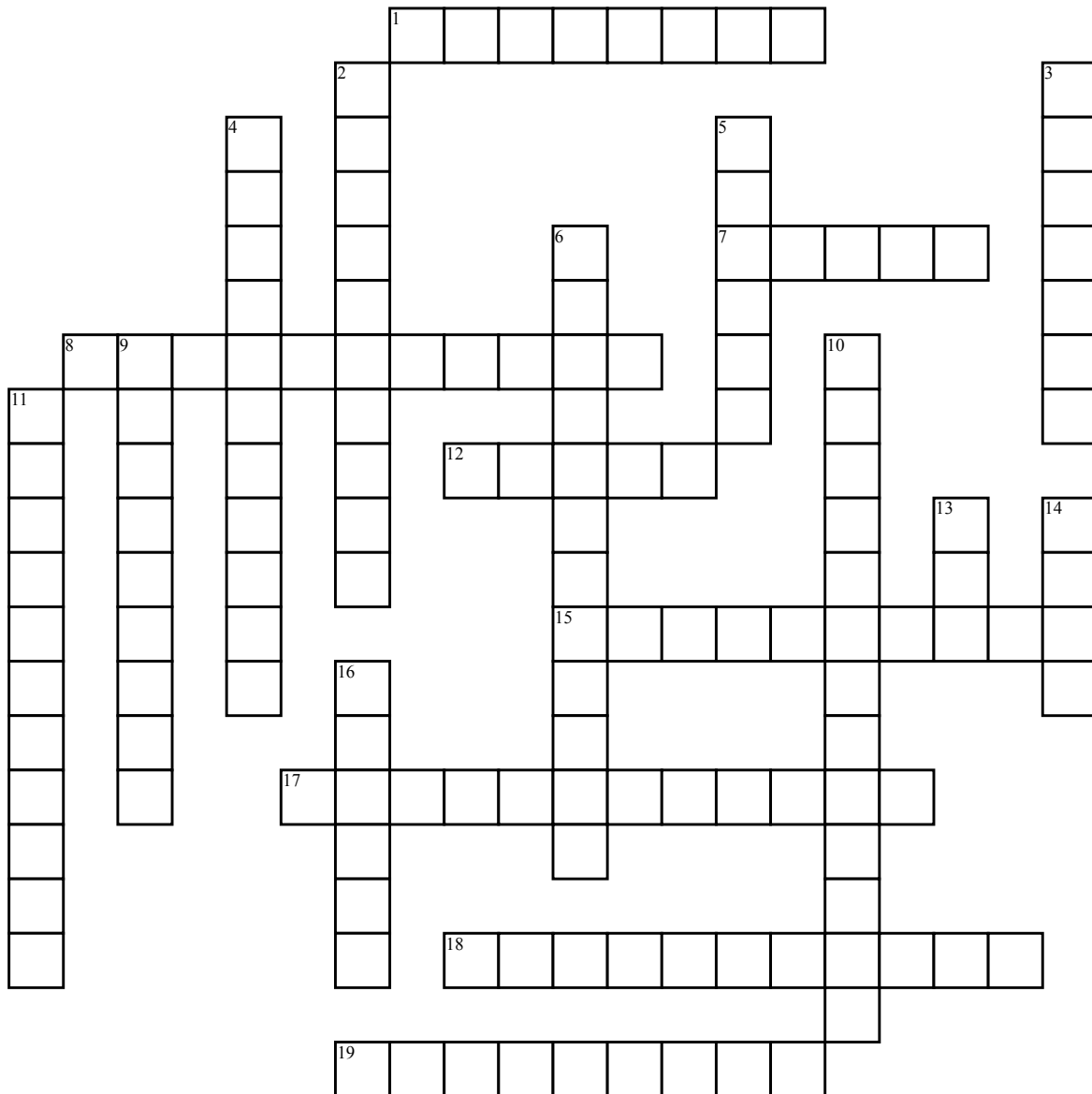

- 1. is a fretted string instrument of the zither family
- 7. considered as part of the tradition or custom of a particular people
- 8. a US folk song, a mountain ballad that was popular among soldiers from eastern Kentucky during World War I and afterwards
- 12. a stringed musical instrument with a long neck and a round open-backed body consisting of parchment stretched over a metal hoop like a tambourine, played by plucking or with a plectrum.
- 15. was an American folk singer and social activist. A fixture on nationwide radio in the 1940s

- 17. a traditional American country folk song popular at various times throughout the United States and Canada
 - 18. a 1938 ballet written by the American composer Aaron Copland
 - 19. Early American folk musicians used to play music with and wash their clothes

- 2. the largest and lowest-pitched instrument of the violin family, providing the bass line of the orchestral string section
 - 3. is a song used in the 2006 Disney-Pixar film Cars
 - 4. American folk singer and actress. Dubbed "The First Lady of the Children's Folk Song"
 - 5. The instrument, which has strings and is played with a bow

- 6. an American composer, composition teacher, writer, and later a conductor of his own and other American music
- 9. was an American folk and blues musician notable for his strong vocals
- 10. known as "the father of American music",
- 11. is a popular American song written by Stephen Foster in 1856, written in honor of Annie Jenkins
- 13. A musical instrument played with buzzed lips to produce a trombone-like tone
- 14. a musical instrument, roughly triangular in shape, consisting of a frame supporting a graduated series of parallel strings, played by plucking with the fingers
- 16. something you can use to play a song or use to eat with
