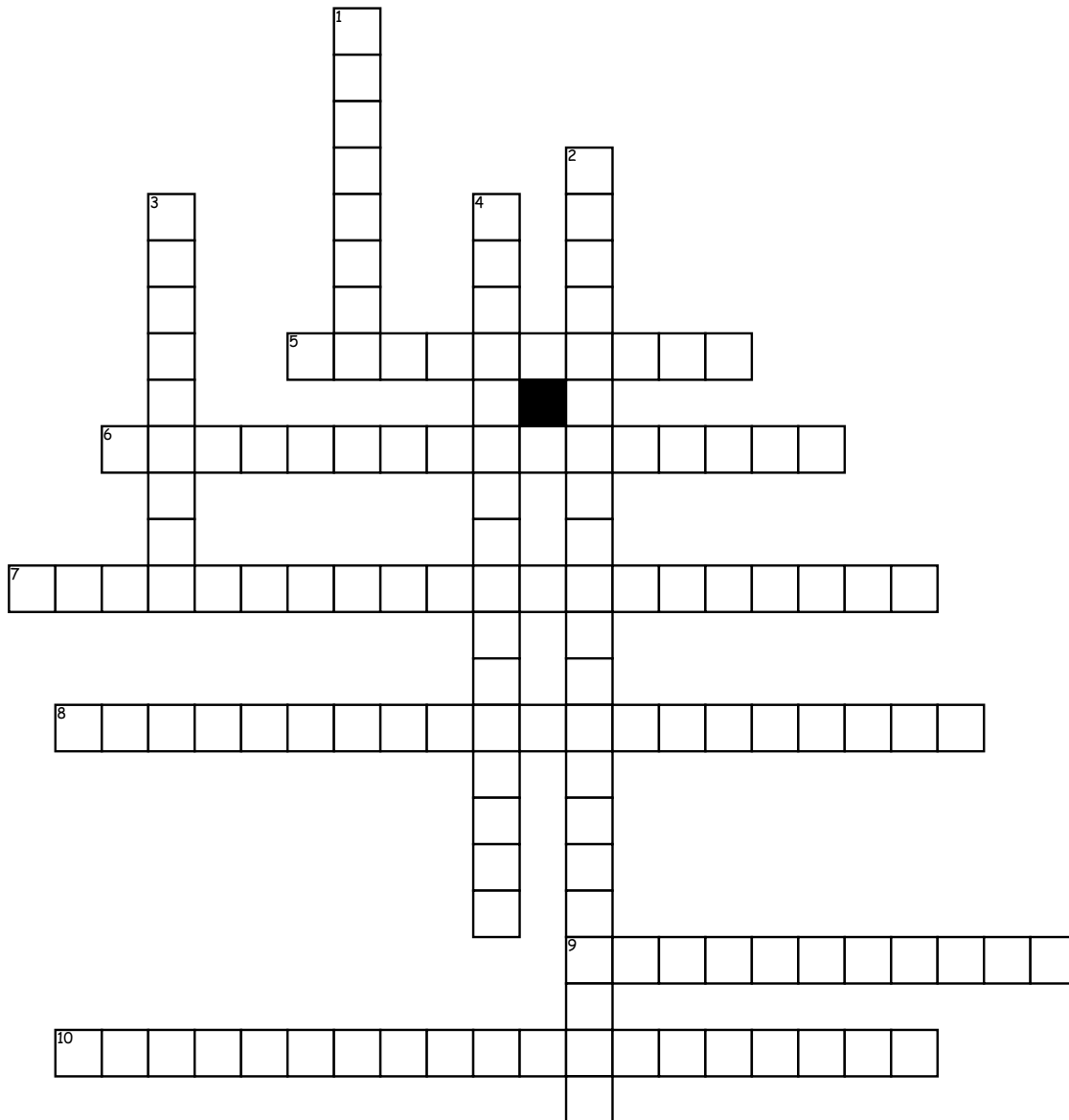


Food Borne Illnesses

- 5. Most common causes of food borne deaths.
- 6. Causes primary septicemia and is especially dangerous for people suffering from liver disease.
- 7. Sourced from home prepared foods
- 8. Bacteria that produces a toxin that causes vomiting shortly after ingesting.
- 9. A bacteria that produces a deadly toxin - sourced in meats.
- 10. Second most common bacterial cause of diarrhea.

- 1. Causes 448,000 cases of diarrhea illness annually.
- 2. A bacteria that produces a serious disease for pregnant women, newborns and adults with a weakened immune system.
- 3. Sourced from undercooked foods or cooked foods that are not reheated after contact with an infected handler.
- 4. A parasite that can lead to a severe disease, especially in children which attacks the central nervous system.
