
Food Borne Illnesses



<u>Across</u>

5. Most common causes of food borne deaths.

6. Causes primary septicemia and is especially dangerous for people suffering from liver disease.

7. Sourced from home prepared foods

8. Bacteria that produces a toxin that causes vomiting shortly after ingesting.

9. A bacteria that produces a deadly toxin - sourced in meats.

10. Second most common bacterial cause of diarrhea.

<u>Down</u>

1. Causes 448,000 cases of diarrhea illness annually.

2. A bacteria that produces a serious disease for pregnant women, newborns and adults with a weakened immune system.

3. Sourced from undercooked foods or cooked foods that are not reheated after contact with an infected handler.

4. A parasite that can lead to a severe disease, especially in children which attacks the central nervous system.
