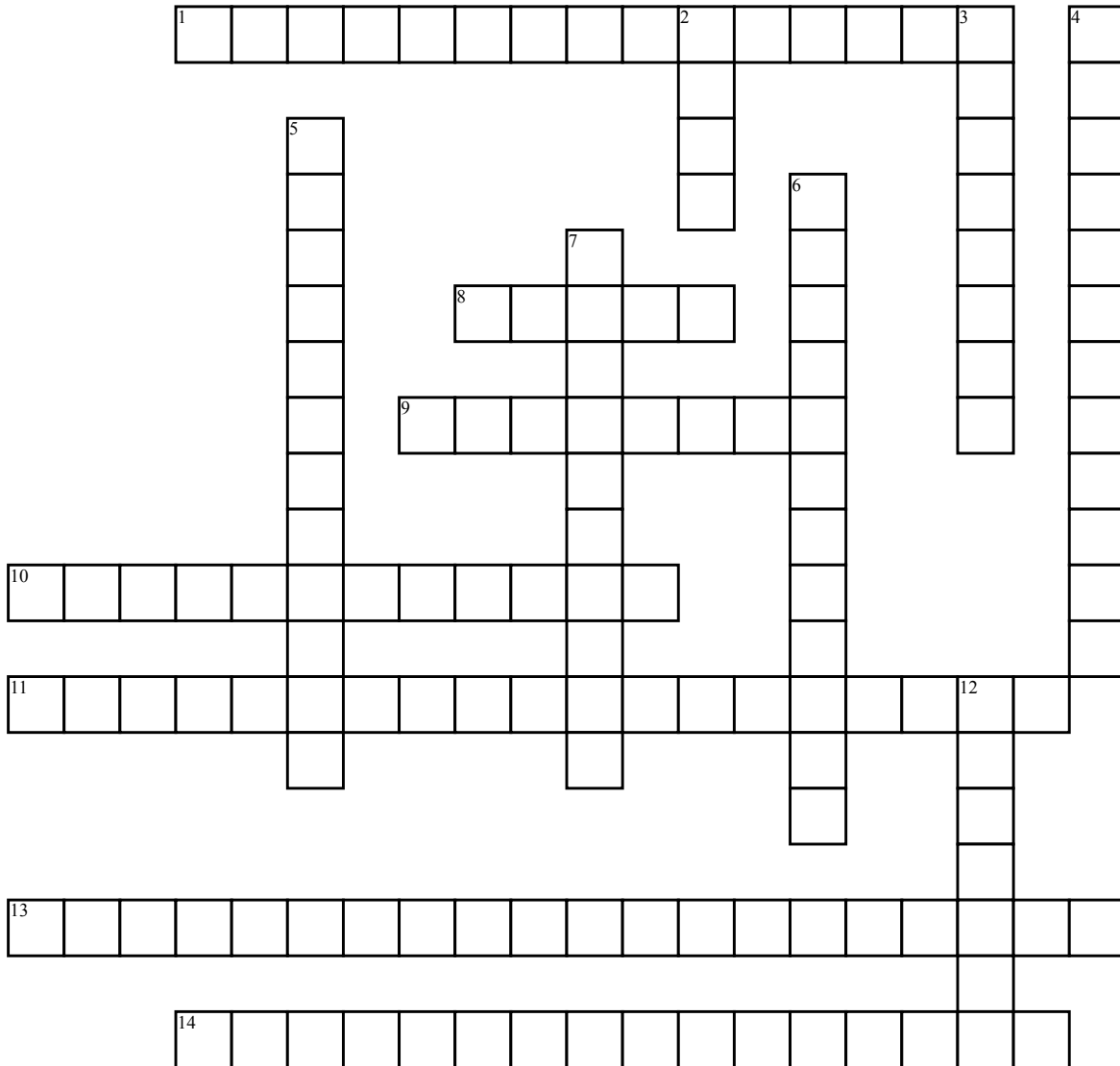


# Forests and Logging
