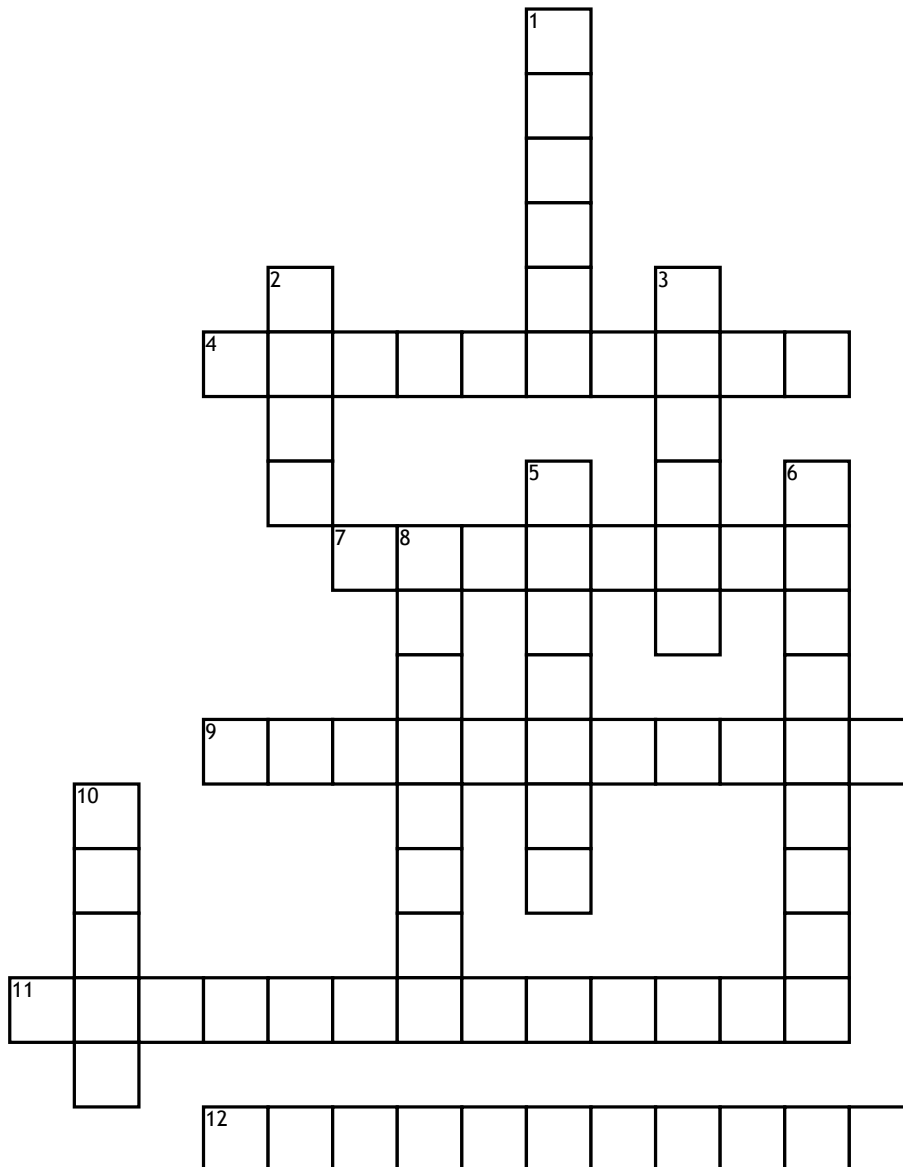


# Forests on Fire 1
