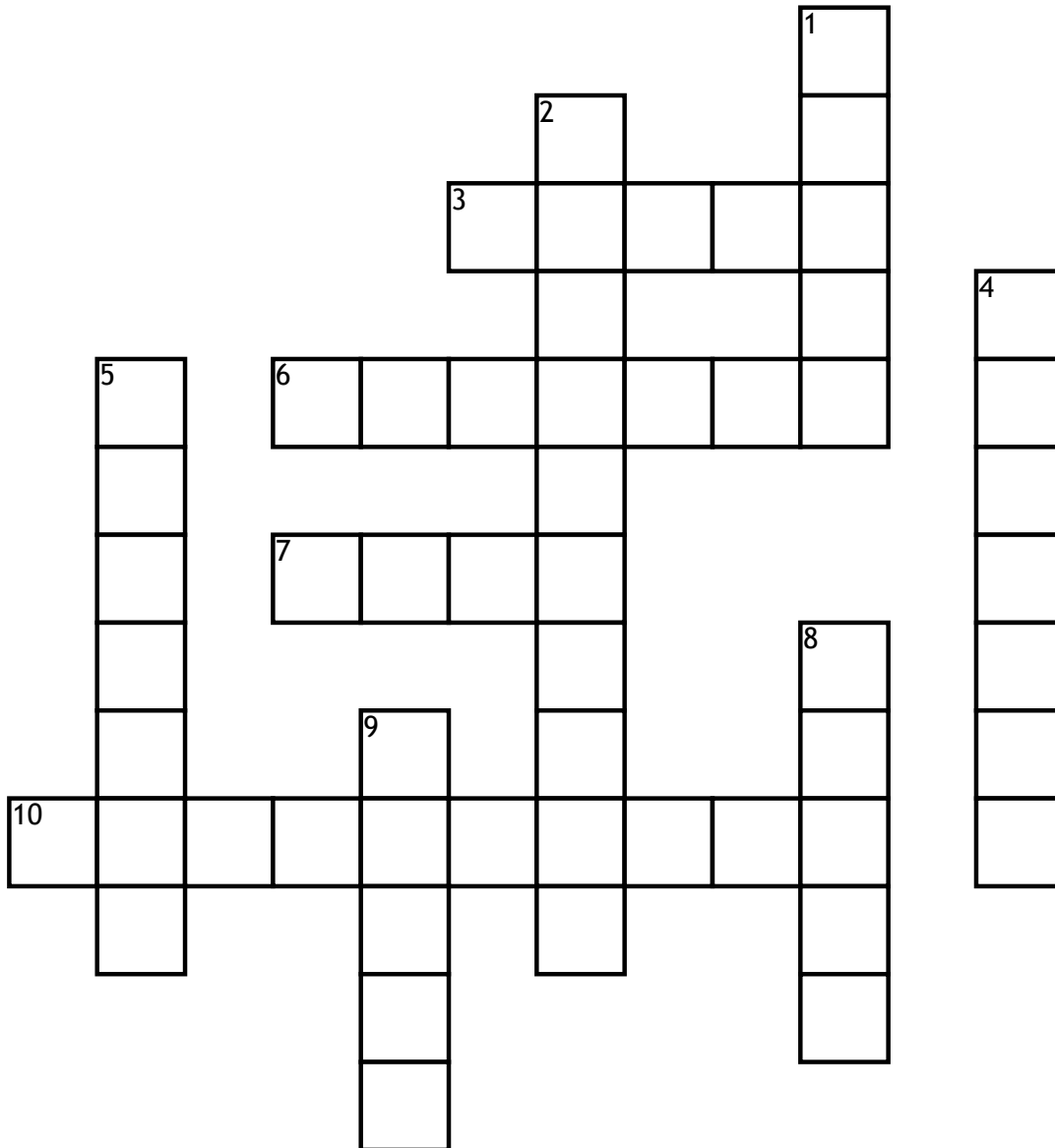


# Fork Truck Safety
