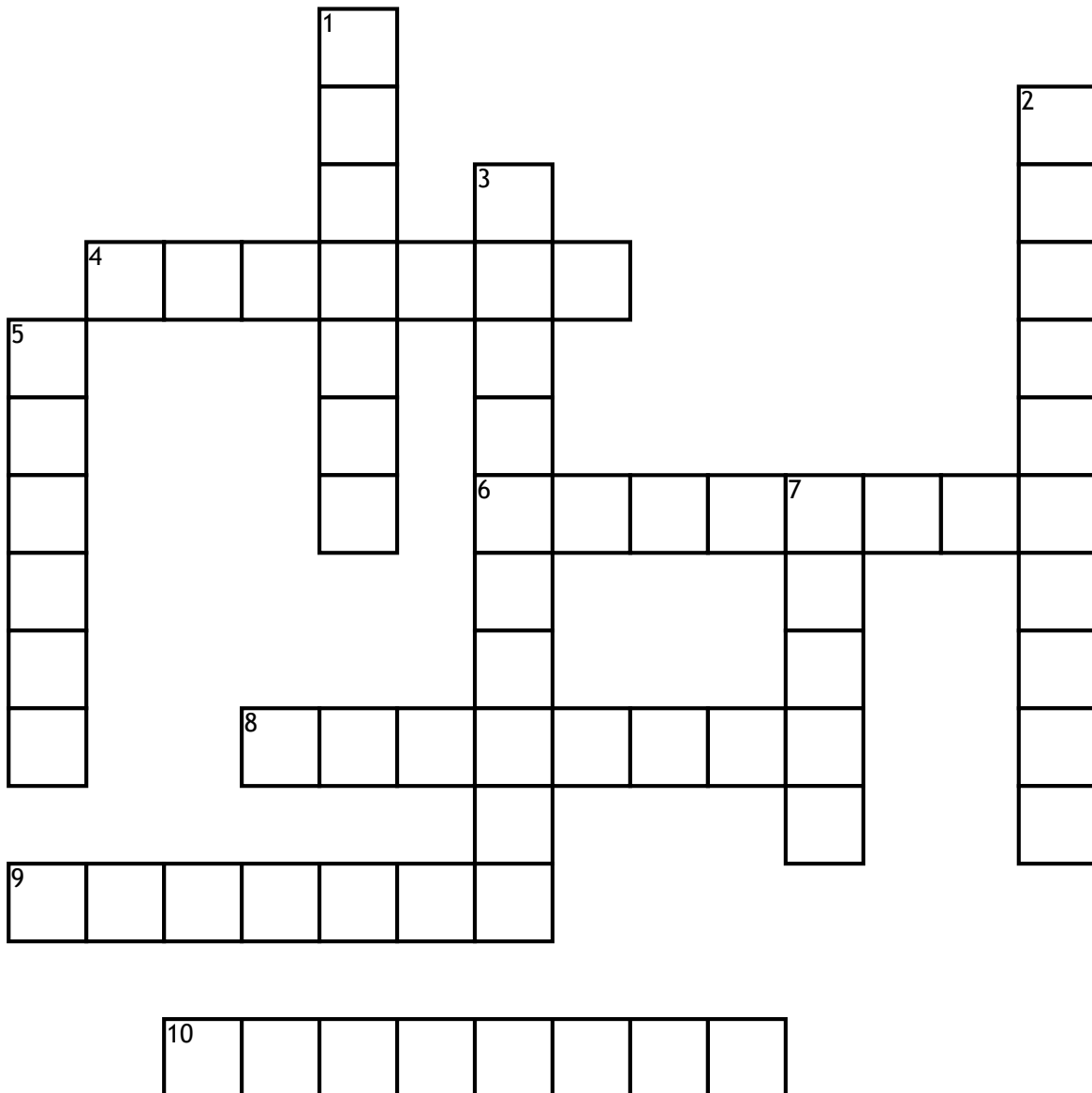

# Formation of Sedimentary Rocks

1. A low area between mountains or hills caused by running water.
2. The breakdown of rock into smaller particles from the effects of wind, water, and ice.
3. The build-up of land by the settlement of sediment and soil in a new location.
5. A deep gorge or valley between plateaus formed by the erosion of moving water and sediment.
7. A triangular landform where a river empties into another body of water.
