

## Across

- **2.** typically arranged in quatrains with the rhyme scheme ABAB
- 4. Tells a story
- **6.** first, last or other letters in a line spell out a particular word or phrase
- **7.** compresses form of metaphor, originally used in Angle-Saxon and Norse poetry
- **8.** a lyric poem, normally addressed to a particular subject

- **10.** a long, serious, poetic narrative about a significant event
- 11. Does not rhyme with fixed forms

- 1. Single character addresses a silent auditor at a critical moment
- **3.** Fixed form poem consisting of 5 tercets and a quatrain
- 5. poem of 14 lines
- **9.** Japanese verse, written in 17 syllables divided into 3 lines of 5 and 7 syllables
