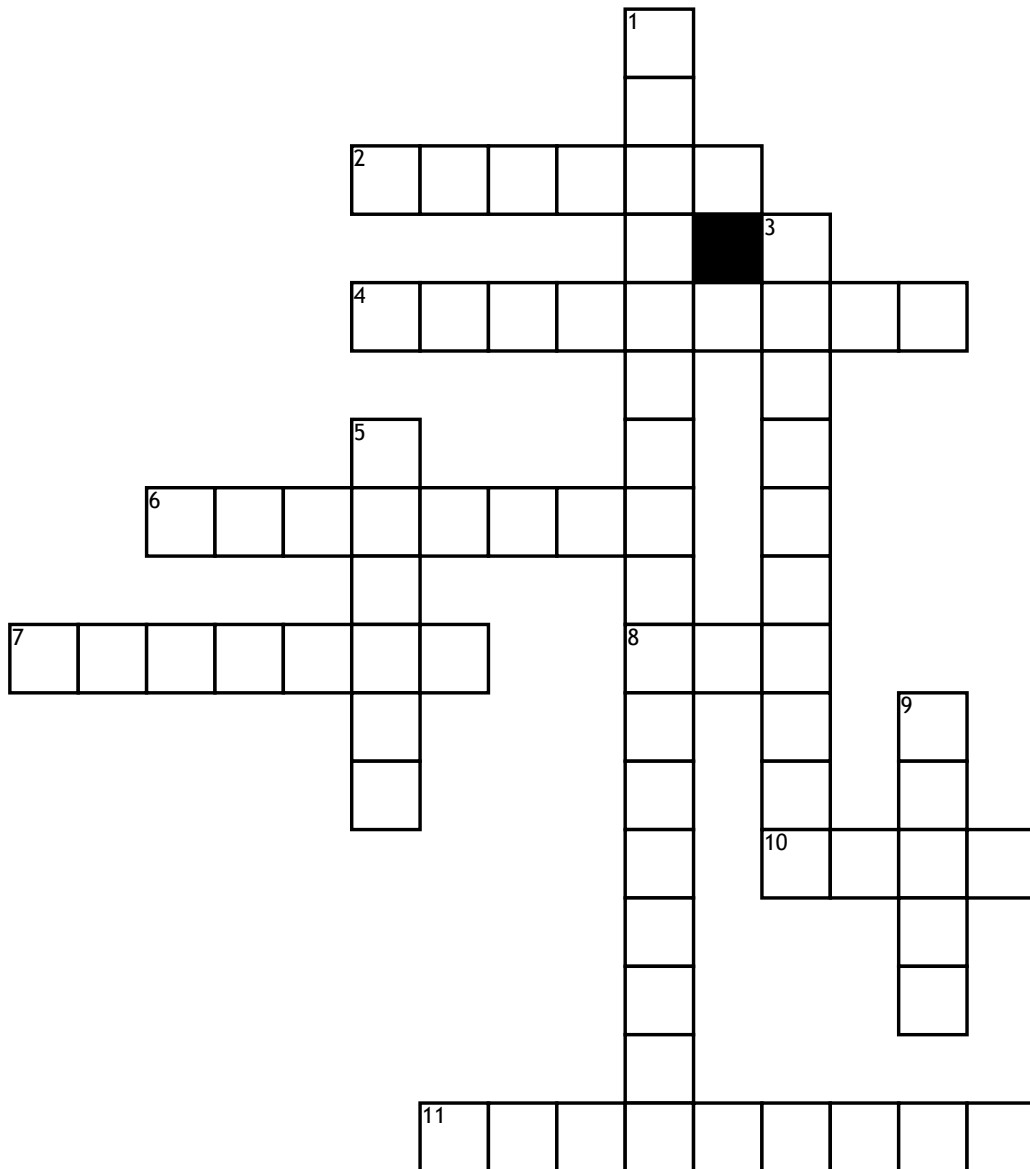

2. typically arranged in quatrains with the rhyme scheme ABAB
4. Tells a story
6. first, last or other letters in a line spell out a particular word or phrase
7. compresses form of metaphor, originally used in Angle-Saxon and Norse poetry
8. a lyric poem, normally addressed to a particular subject

10. a long, serious, poetic narrative about a significant event

11. Does not rhyme with fixed forms

1. Single character addresses a silent auditor at a critical moment

3. Fixed form poem consisting of 5 tercets and a quatrain

5. poem of 14 lines

9. Japanese verse, written in 17 syllables divided into 3 lines of 5 and 7 syllables
