

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Forms of Contamination

- **6.** Pathogens are a form of this contamination, found naturally in food
- **8.** A protein in a food or ingredient that some are sensitive to
- **10.** Contaminates consisting of bones, metal shavings, fingernails, glass, dirt, etc.
- **11.** Found in the feces of humans

- **12.** Linked to ready-to-eat food and shellfish from contaminated water; found in feces of infected humans
- **13.** Requires a host to live and reproduce
- **14.** Found in the intestines of cattle

- 1. Carried naturally in farm animals and linked with poultry, eggs, meat, dairy products, and produce
- **2.** Conditions for bacteria to grow

- **3.** Contaminates consisting of cleaners, sanitizers, polishes, perfumes, lubricants etc
- **4.** Characterized by nausea, hives, swelling, itchy rashes, abdominal pain, wheezing
- **5.** Lives only in humans, found in ready to eat food and beverages
- 7. Transferred to food via infected food handlers touching food or equipment
- **9.** Yeasts, molds, and mushrooms
