

3. One ruler has supreme authority that is not restricted by any written laws
4. One person rules with unlimited power in a government
8. The people decide what goes on in the government directly
9. A society in which all property is publicly owned and each person works and is paid according to their abilities and needs.

1. The principle of elected officials representing a group of people

2. A group of people rule with unlimited power
5. One person who has complete control over the government by election, inherited, or taken by force
6. A state in which supreme power is held by the people and their elected representatives, and which has an elected or nominated president
7. Theory of social organization that believes that the means of making, moving, and trading wealth should be owned or controlled by the community as a whole
10. One person rules with limited power
