

- 3. Home of an ancient clam garden and the Mahoi homestead
- 5. Creatures desolating Sidney Island's under forests
- 13. Location of GINPR's own mini Grouse Grind (Mount)
- 14. Island gifted to Princess Margaret in 1958 and she gave it back in 1967 when it became a park
- 15. 'Thank you' in SENĆOŦEN
- 17. Popular park & campground on Salt Spring often assumed by the public to be a part of GINPR (but isn't)
- 19. SENĆOŦEN word meaning 'The Place of Pitch'
- 20. One of two places in GINPR protected under the Heritage Lighthouse Protection Act (Point)
- 21. Lake area of high bat activity and invasive bullfrog sightings

- 23. Property that got its name from settlers Robert Jr & Irene Roe
  - 25. Site of backcountry camping on island still mostly owned by descendants of Digby de Burgh (Bay)
  - 26. Former home of a Leper colony
  - 28. Shore where Moby Doll was harpooned from

- 1. Island formerly known as Rum
  - 2. Location of Best Echo and prettiest water in GINPR (Bay)
  - 4. Despite its name implying 100, this location has only been a part of GINPR for 18yrs
  - 6. Campground in GINPR named after the tree that sheds its reddish bark (Point)
  - 7. GINPR's only salmon-bearing stream empties into this body of water (Harbour)
  - 8. Location of an abandoned Saturnelite mine (Cove)

- 9. Where Haro Straight, Georgia Straight and Fraser River waters meet
- 10. Island(s) named in 1859 after the Senior Survey Officer under Captain Plumper, also called SDAÿ ES
- 11. Name of Southern Resident Killer Whale known as L86 (she is the mother to baby girl L125 born 2021)
- 12. Where beavers and dams don't mix (Lake)
- 16. GINPR island with the 'long nose'
- 18. Island shaped more like a slice of pizza than the round object its name suggests
- 22. Only place in all of Canada to find the Slender Popcorn Flower (Mount)
- 24. A CPEP (Climate, People and the Environment Program) sanctuary. (Spit)
- 27. Island that has been the site of a coal mine, a fox farm and experimental prescribed burns
