

5. Chest pain and heartburn
6. Absence or ineffective peristalsis in the distal part of the oesophagus accompanied by the oesophageal sphincter failing to relax during swallowing.

9. impaired transport across the mucosa

11. tarry or black stools; indicative of blood in stools

12. an involuntary spasm of the diaphragm and respiratory organs, with a sudden closure of the glottis and a characteristic gulping sound

15. Cheesy white plaque that looks like milk curds; when rubbed off, it leaves an erythematous and often bleeding base **17.** Bad breath

18. breathing of fluids or foods into the trachea and lungs; removal of substance by suction

19. dry mouth
