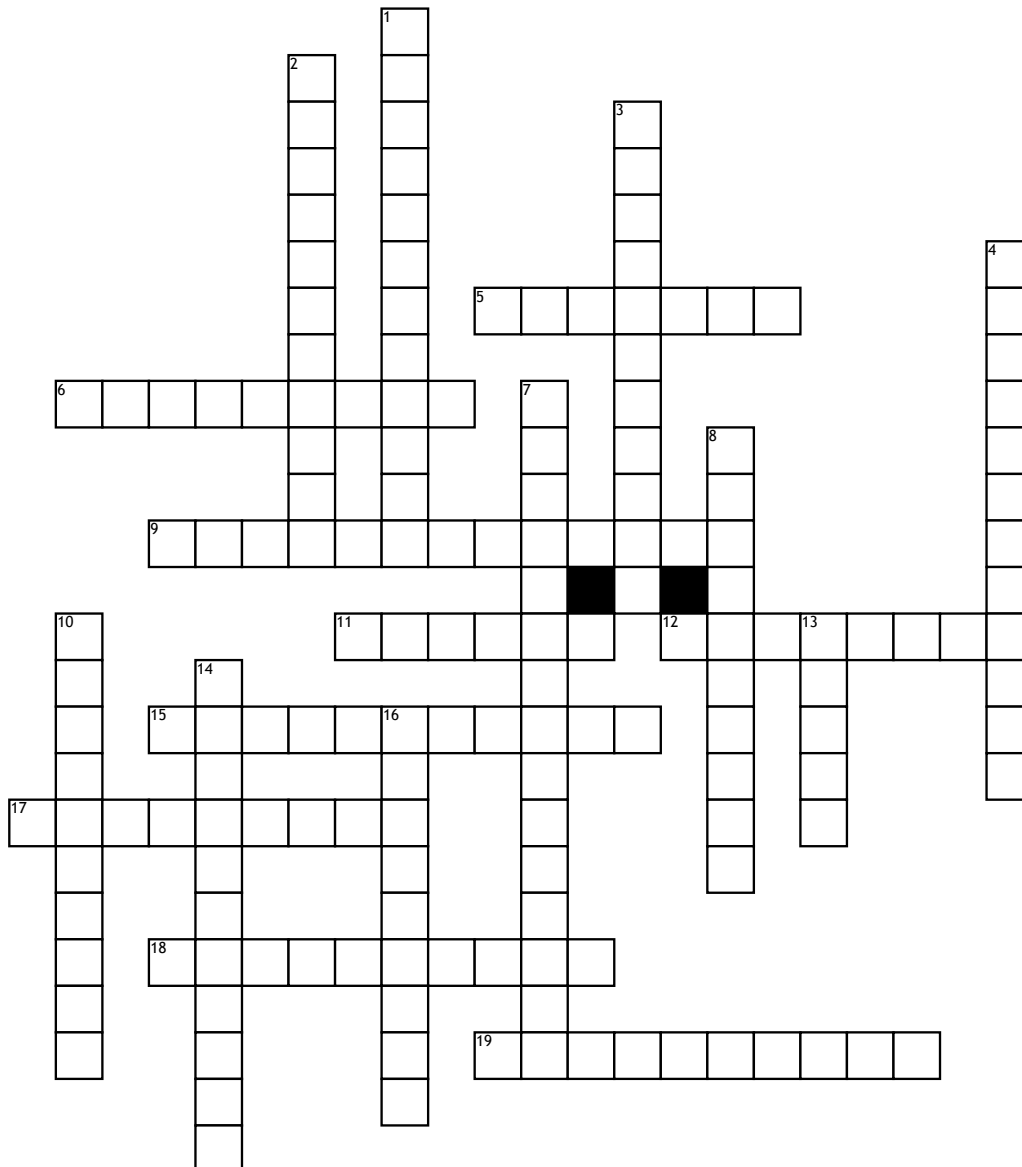

Across

5. Chest pain and heartburn
 6. Absence or ineffective peristalsis in the distal part of the oesophagus accompanied by the oesophageal sphincter failing to relax during swallowing.
 9. impaired transport across the mucosa
 11. tarry or black stools; indicative of blood in stools
 12. an involuntary spasm of the diaphragm and respiratory organs, with a sudden closure of the glottis and a characteristic gulping sound
 15. Cheesy white plaque that looks like milk curds; when rubbed off, it leaves an erythematous and often bleeding base
 17. Bad breath

18. breathing of fluids or foods into the trachea and lungs; removal of substance by suction
 19. dry mouth

1. infectious and inflammatory process of the appendix creating acute abdominal pain and nausea azotorrhea
 2. White patches; may be hyperkeratotic; usually in buccal mucosa; usually painless
 3. Acute pain on swallowing
 4. the excretion of abnormal quantities of fat with the faeces owing to reduced absorption of fat by the intestine.
 7. physiologic response to rapid emptying of gastric contents into the jejunum

8. Painful, inflamed, swollen gums; usually the gums bleed in response to light contact
 10. inflammation of the oral mucosa
 13. semi-liquid mass of food mixed with saliva, mucus, salivary and gastric enzymes and gastric juices which passes from stomach to intestines
 14. surgical creation of an opening into the stomach for the purpose of administering foods and fluids
 16. Difficulty swallowing
