

## Across

- 2. Herniation of abominal contents through the ubilical ring, usually with an intact peritoneal sac.
- 7. Congenital megacolon
- **8.** Malrotation of the intestine that disrupts blood flow to the intestine
- **10.** Another name for acute diarrhea
- **11.** Alteration in frequency, consistency or ease of passage of stool

**12.** Telescoping of one portion of intestine into another

## Down

- 1. Complication from failure of the omphalomesenteric duct to fuse during embryonic development
- **3.** Herniation lateral to the umbilical ring and peritoneal sac
- **4.** Characterized by pain in RLQ and high WBC count

- **5.** Effortless passage of gastric contents into mouth or esophagus
- 6. Surgery that involves creating a one-way valve by wrapping gastric fundus 360 degrees around the lower end of the esophagus
- **9.** Protrusion of part of an organ through cavity wall
