1. The cavity or tube within a tube or tubular organ. A. Anastomosis
2. Infolding of one segment of the intestine into the lumen of another segment B. Hematemesis
3. Surgical jointing of two ducts, blood vessels, or bowel segments to allow flow from one to the other. C. Dysphagia
4. A white, firmly attached patch on the mouth or tongue mucosa D. Leukoplakia
5. A rapid gastric emptying of undigested food from the stomach to the small intestine. E. Achalasia
6. Vomiting blood F. Melena
7. Difficulty swallowing G. Intussusception
8. Upset stomach and other vague GI complaints H. Lumen
9. Black, tarry stool with undigested blood I. Dyspepsia
10. Abnormal condition characterized by the inability of a muscle to relax, particularly the cardiac sphincter of the stomach. Also called "cardiospasm". J. Dumping syndrome
