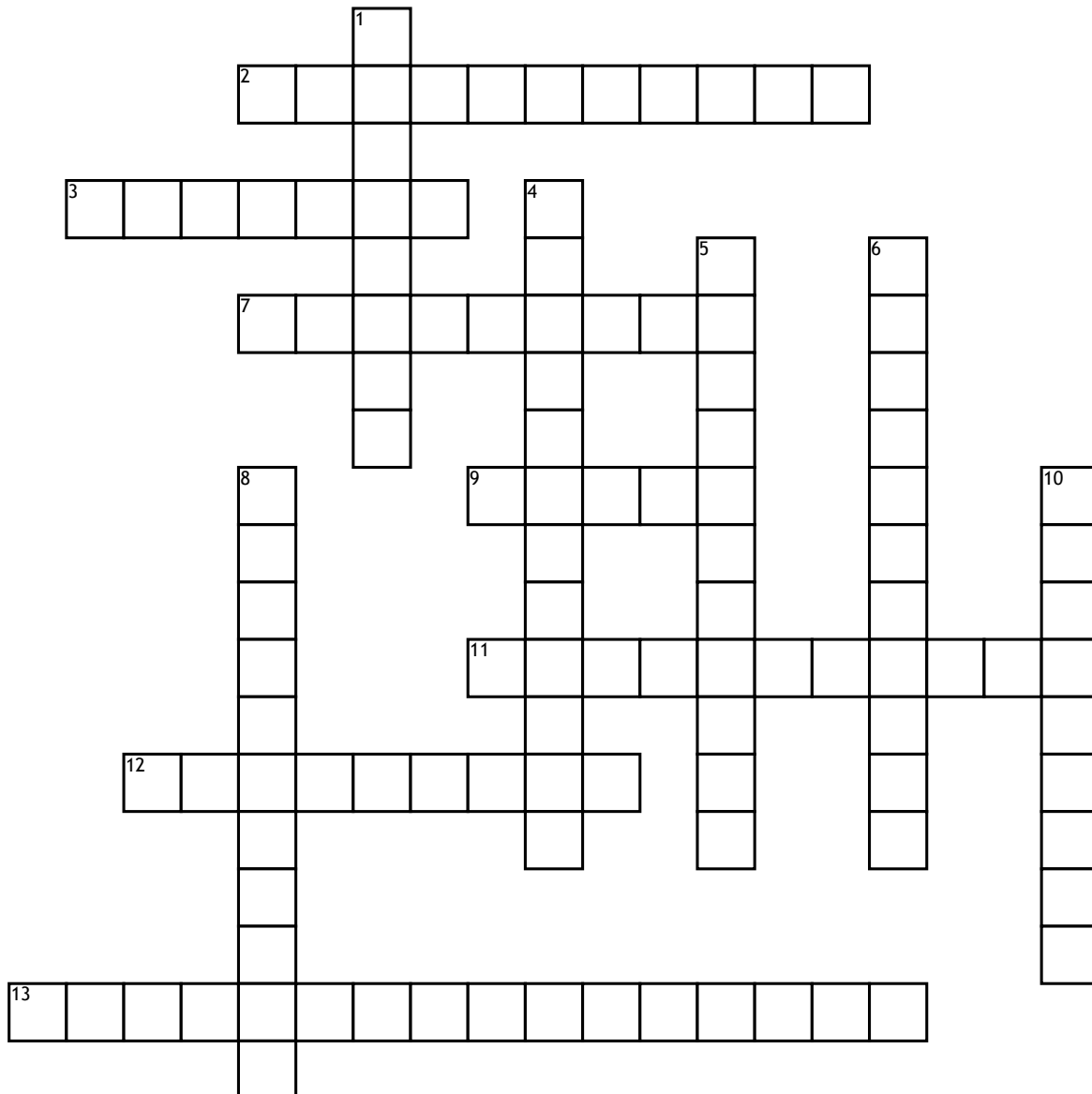


# Gender



## Across

2. a term to describe someone who moves between binary constructions of gender and whose gender and identity and expressions vary over time
3. people who identify as not having a gender or being genderless. They can exist outside of the gender binary, be gender non-conforming and/or identify as trans
7. people whose gender identify and assigned sex are the same
9. term to describe people whose gender identity and assigned sex are different. It can be used for a range of identities and experiences
11. people whose gender expression and/or identity is between, across (both) or outside of the binary and/or does not conform to gender norms

12. someone whose gender identity and/or expression does not conform to the socially constructed gender binary
13. how a person publicly presents their gender (behavior, outward appearance, etc.)

## Down

1. an umbrella term used to describe people who have chromosomes, hormonal profiles or genitals that do not typically fit into binary medical and social constructions of male and female
4. describes the system in which a society classifies all people into one of two categories (men and women), each with associated stereotypes and norms
5. the systemic and individual oppression of people whose gender identity and gender expression do not conform to cisgender identities

6. an umbrella term used to describe people who exist outside of the gender binary. For some people that means the construction of a new gender
8. doctors usually determine a baby to be either male or female at birth
10. a term used by only Indigenous people to identify themselves, describes complex experiences and identities. Can refer to sexual orientation and/or gender identity, depending on the individual or nation
