


Gender Inequality

- 2. Members of early women's movements who pressed for equal voting rights for women and men.
- 3. Social expectations about behavior deemed appropriate for the members of each sex
- 8. The biological and anatomical differences distinguishing females from males.
- 9. Form of feminist theory that thinks gender inequality is caused by unequal access to civil rights and certain social resources, such as education and employment, based on sex.
- 10. The intentional killing of a newborn. Female babies are more likely than male babies to be murdered in cultures that devalue women.

- 11. The forcing of nonconsensual vaginal, oral, or anal intercourse.
