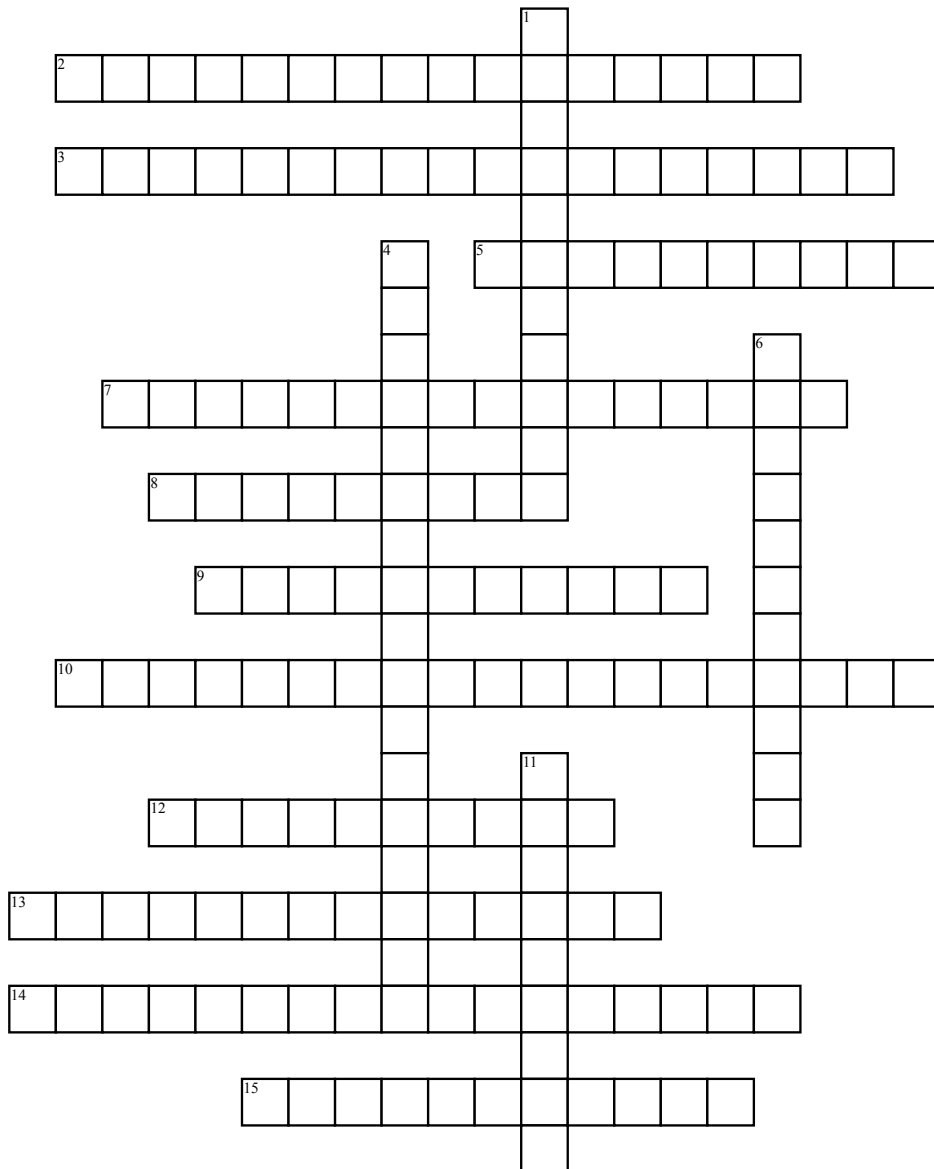

2. effect from drugs that slow down cell function
