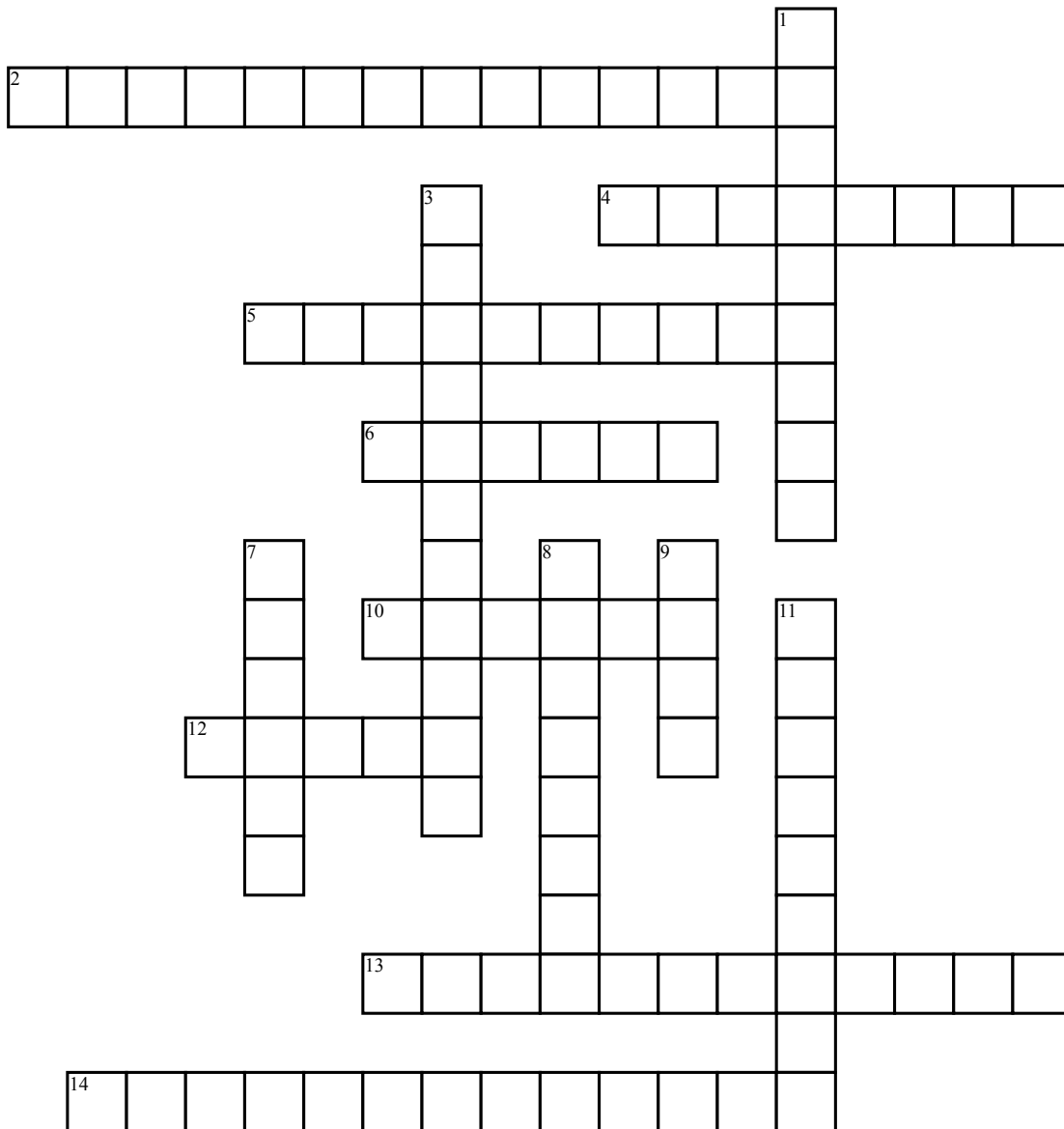


Genetics Crossword
