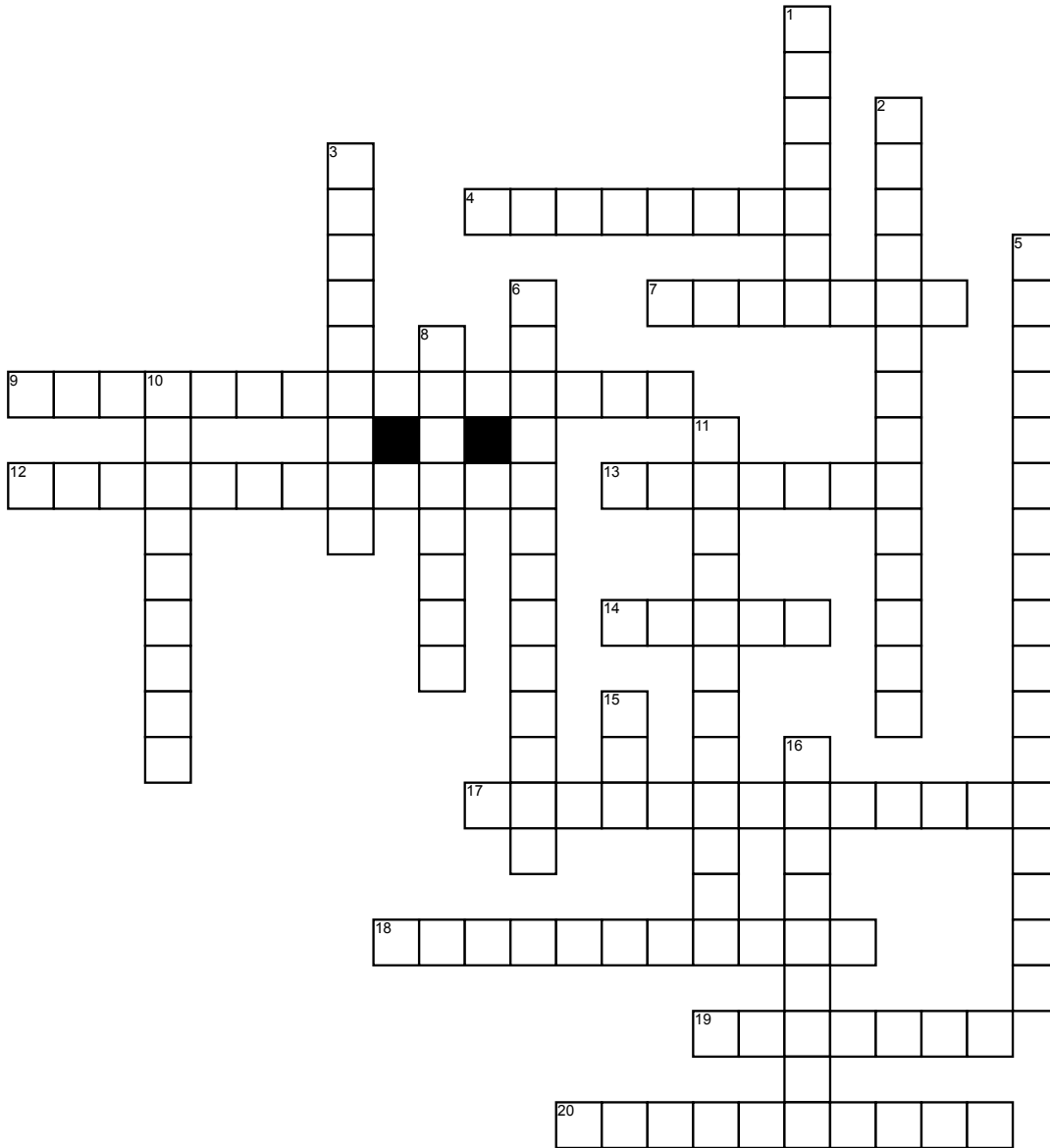

- 1.** Time zones in degrees longitude
2. Degrees on a compass, measured in a clockwise direction from 0 degrees (north) to 360 degrees
3. Distance in the East and West of the Prime Meridian
5. Found when you take population and divide it by km squared
6. Line of longitude on maps or globes that join the North and South pole

- 8.** Distance north or south of the equator, measured in degrees parallel
10. Line divided into units that represent actual lines on the ground
11. Direction on a compass, such as North and South
