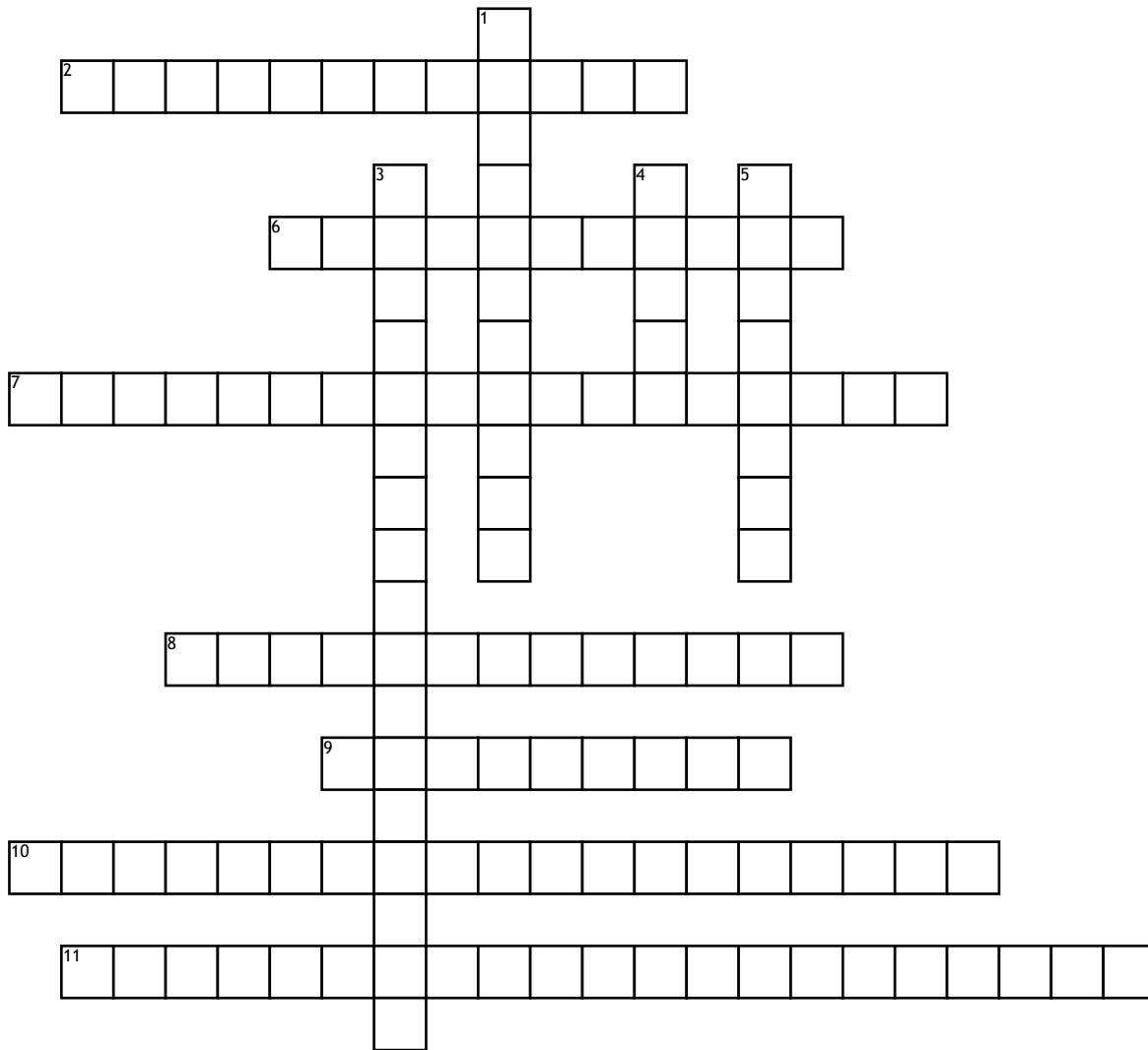


# Geographic Literacy

2. Directions on a compass such as North and South.
6. A map that shows very specific information on one particular topic.
7. A map projection that greatly distorts the size of land masses.
8. When the features of a globe are transferred onto a flat surface.
9. Distance east and west of the Prime Meridian, measured in degrees.
10. A way of showing maps that shows the correct size of countries in relation to each other.

11. A line that generally follows the 180 degree line of longitude where one day ends and the next begins.

1. Shows directions and bearings used to indicate direction on maps.
3. Provides many types of information on one map.
4. Compares distance between points on the map with the actual distance between those points on the Earth's surface.
5. Distance north and south of the equator, measured in degrees.
