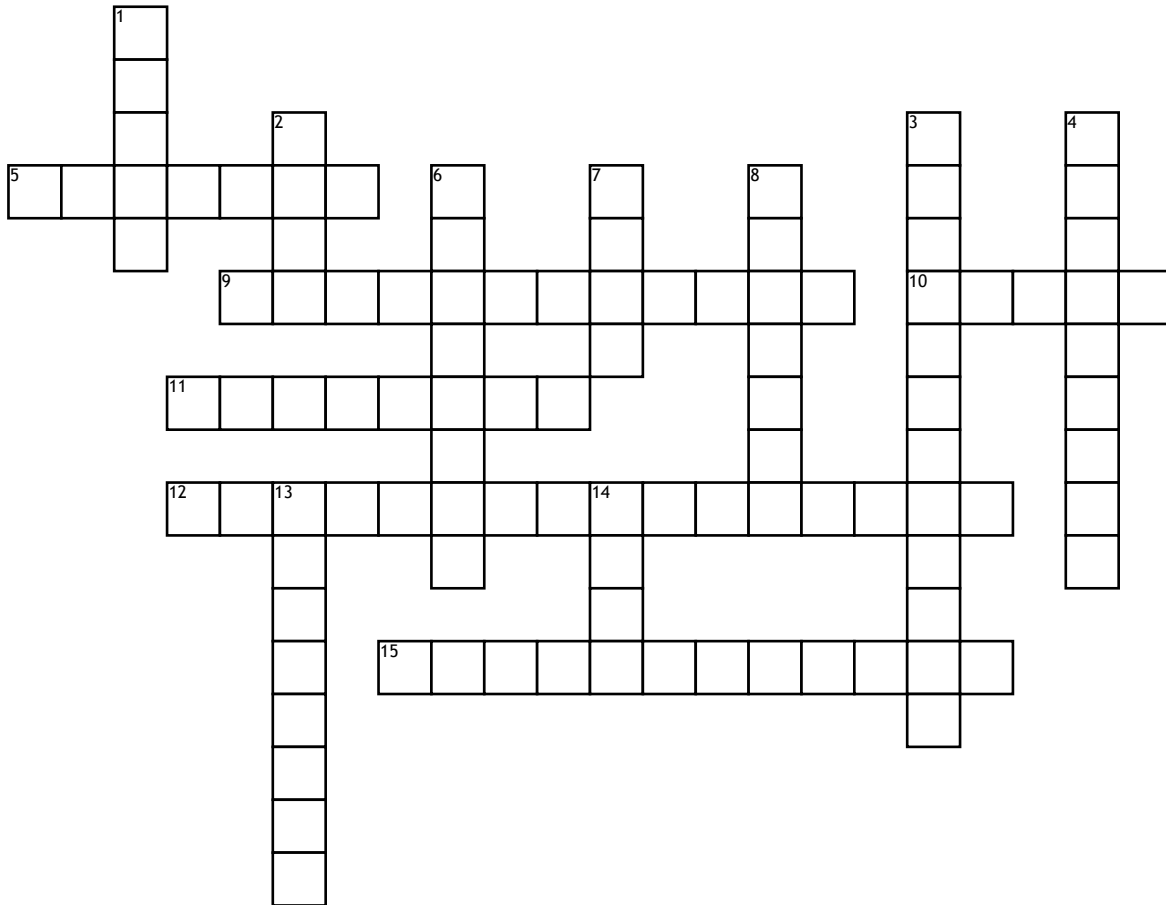


Glacier crossword puzzle
