

- **2.** A mound of layered sediment deposited at the retreating glacier face
- 6. A large, moving mass of ice
- **7.** Glaciers that cover broad, continental areas
- **8.** Streams flowing under melting glaciers leave long, winding ridges of layered sediments
- **9.** Valley glaciers also scoop out deep depressions called

10. The area at the leading edge of the glacier where the meltwater flows and deposits outwash

- 1. Glaciers that form in valleys in high, mountainous areas.
- **3.** Continental glaciers that move over older moraines form the material into elongated landforms called
- 4. Glaciers deposit unsorted ridges of till
- **5.** A steep-sided depression formed by a glacier
