

- **3.** A long ridge of gravel and other sediment.
- **4.** A mass of rocks and sediment carried down and deposited by a glacier.
- 7. A river that is either too large or too small to have eroded the valley or cave passage in which it flows.

- **10.** A permanent layer of ice covering an extensive tract of land, especially a polar region.
- 12. Also known as, bolder clay.
