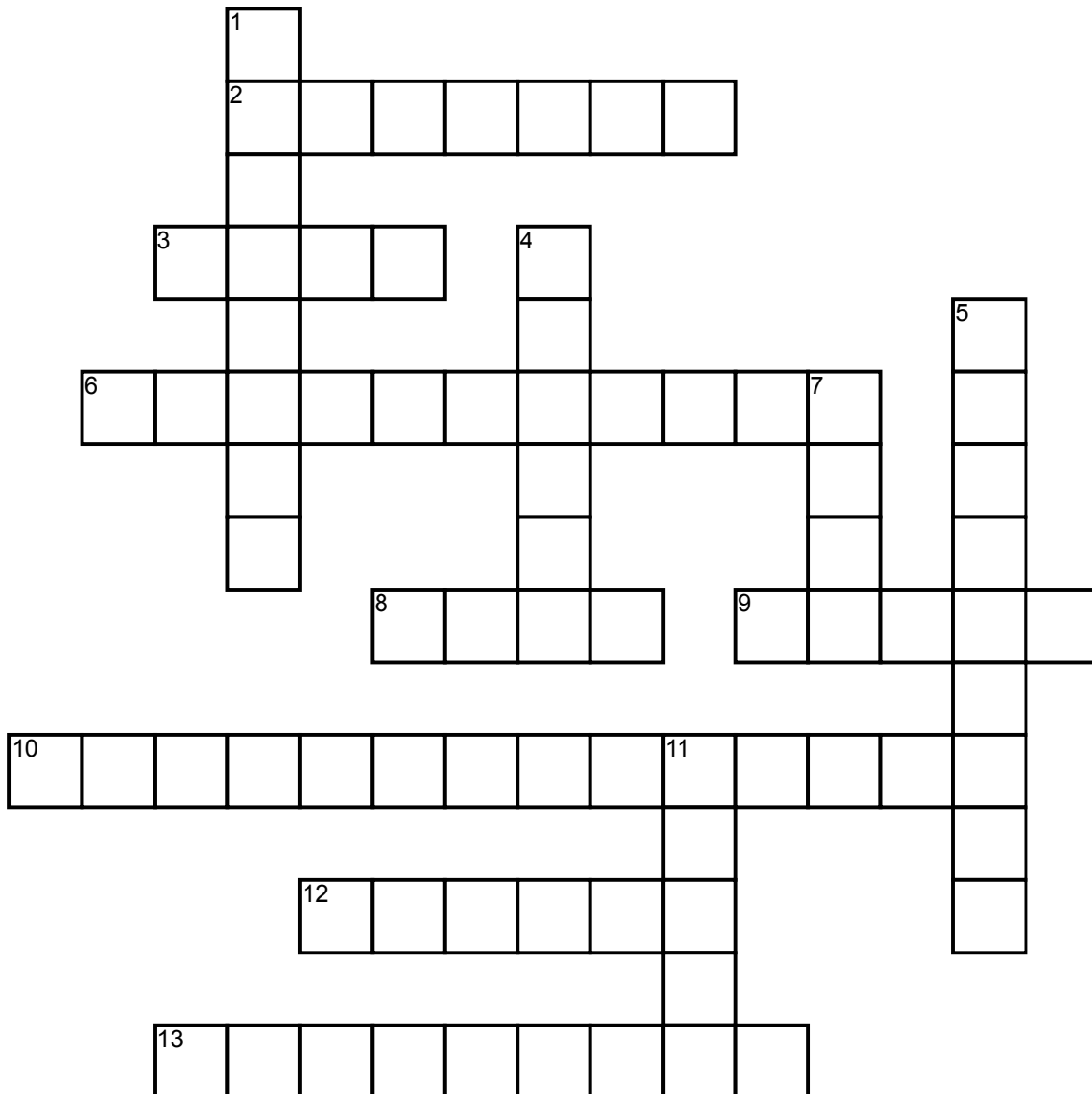

- 2.** an emphasis on a particular note or chord
3. any or several symbols placed at the left hand and of a staff indicating the pitch of the notes written on it
6. a temporary displacement of the regular metrical accent caused typically by stressing the weak beat
8. interval of silence of a specified duration
9. the basic, rhythmic pattern of beats in a piece of music

- 10.** an indication of rhythm following a clef generally expressed as a fraction with a denominator defining the beat as a division of a semi-breve and the numerator giving the number of beats in each bar
12. a strong, regular, repeated pattern of movement or sound
13. a continually repeated musical phrase or rhythm

- 1.** a vertical line used in a musical score to mark a division between bars

- 4.** any set of musical notes ordered by fundamental frequency or pitch
5. one or more unstressed notes before the first bar line in a piece or passage
7. single tone of definite pitch made by a musical instrument or the human voice
