

- **6.** a temporary displacement of the regular metrical accent caused tipically by stressing the weak beat

- **9.** the basic, rhythmic pattern of beats in a piece of music
- 10. an indication of rhythm following a clef generally expressed as a fraction with a denominator defining the beat as a divison of a semi-breve and the numerator giving the number of beats in each bar

- **13.** a continually repeated musical phrase or rhythm
