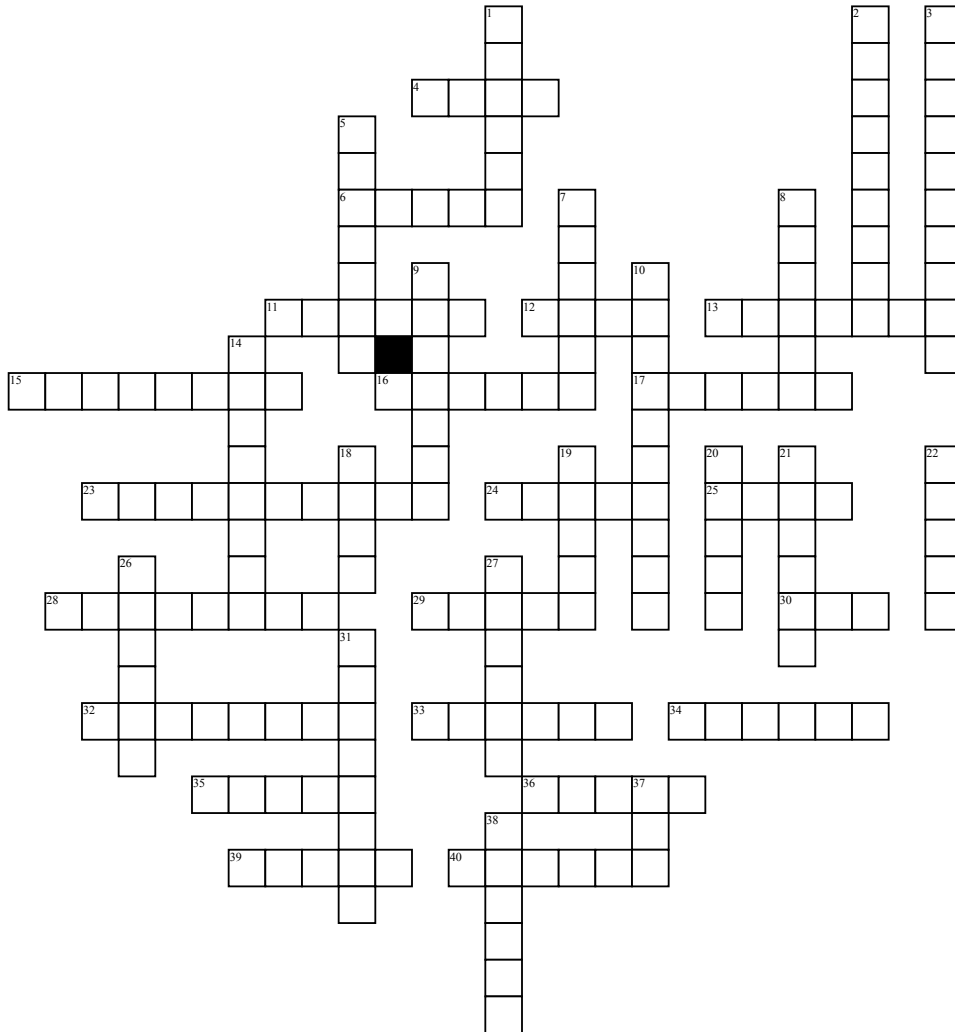


God and Goddesses Crossword Puzzle

- 16. Deimos is the personification of dread and terror.
- 17. The Greek god of sleep.
- 23. Greek goddess of the sea, wife of Poseidon and a Nereid.
- 24. A minor god of vegetation, fruits of the earth and rebirth.
- 25. God of war. Represented the physical, violent and untamed aspect of war.
- 28. The Greek goddess of harmony and concord.
- 29. A sea nymph whose name represented the bounty of the sea. Mother of the Nereids.
- 30. Primordial goddess of the night.
- 32. God of dreams and sleep – has the ability to take any human form and appear in dreams.

- 33. Olympian god of music, poetry, art, oracles, archery, plague, medicine, sun, light and knowledge.

 - 35. Goddess of gardens, flowers, swamps, and marshes.
 - 36. God of the Dead and Riches and King of the Underworld.
 - 39. The god of dedication, emulation, eager rivalry, envy, jealousy, and zeal.
 - 40. Primordial god of the sky and heavens, and father of the Titans.

- 1. The Greek god of wealth.
 - 2. Goddess of love and beauty and married to Hephaestus.
 - 3. A group of gods that came before all else.
 - 5. Goddess of agriculture, fertility, sacred law and the harvest.
 - 7. The Titan god of the sea before Poseidon and father of the Nereids (nymphs of the sea).
 - 8. Youngest of the Three Fates and responsible for spinning the thread of human life.
 - 9. One of the Muses, the muse of music and lyric poetry.

- 10. God of fire, metalworking, stone masonry, forges and the art of sculpture. Created weapons for the gods and married to Aphrodite.
- 14. Olympian Greek god of the sea, earthquakes, storms, and horses.
- 18. Goddess of victory, known as the Winged Goddess of Victory.
- 19. The Primordial Titan of Astronomy. Condemned by Zeus to carry the world on his back after the Titans lost the war.
- 20. Spirit goddess of insanity, madness, crazed frenzy and the dead.
- 21. Goddess of the Moon, sometimes referred to as Luna and the 'mother' of vampires.
- 22. A goddess of magic who transformed her enemies, or those that insulted her, into beasts.
- 26. Messenger of the sea and the son of Poseidon and Amphitrite.
- 27. The god of time. Not to be confused with Cronus, the Titan father of Zeus.
- 31. The Evening Star – the planet Venus in the evening.
- 37. A Titaness and the goddess of the dawn.
- 38. God of strength and power.
