
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## Golf crossword



## **Across**

- 1. A shot used when close to the hole. Usually used when on the green
- 3. The round hole on each green
- **6.** The area at the start of each hole from where players drive the ball.
- **9.** This rare score occurs when the golfer's tee shot goes into the hole.
- **10.** The surface area of the club head used for striking the ball.
- **13.** When a golfer is two strokes under par for a given hole.

- **14.** A pond or stream. If a ball lands in water and is unable to be played, the golfer takes a penalty stroke.
- **15.** The short grassy surface where the cup is located

## **Down**

- 2. A shot used on a short approach, in which the ball is popped up in the air in such a manner as to have it roll toward the pin when it lands on the green
- **4.** Sand-filled pits on fairways and next to greens that are placed as hazards on a course.

- **5.** The long stretch of neatly trimmed grass that runs between the tee box and the green.
- **7.** Term describing a golfer's first stroke from the tee box on every hole.
- **8.** When the number of strokes it takes to sink the ball in a hole exceeds the par by one.
- **11.** Scored by a player who sinks the ball in the cup one stroke under par for that hole
- **12.** Describes the ball that lies farthest from the cup when two or more golfers are playing. The away ball is always the first one played on each turn.
