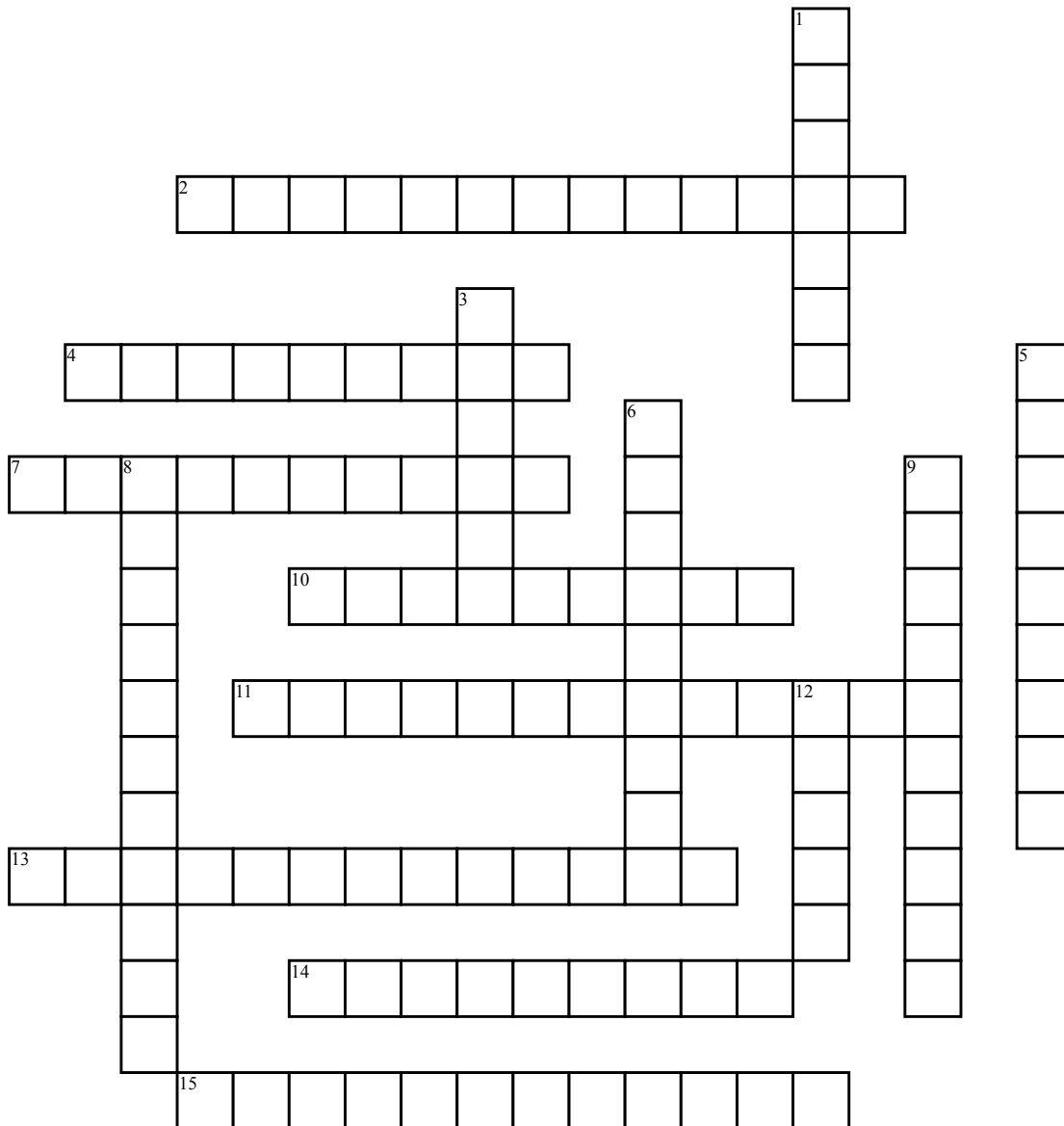


# Government Crossword
