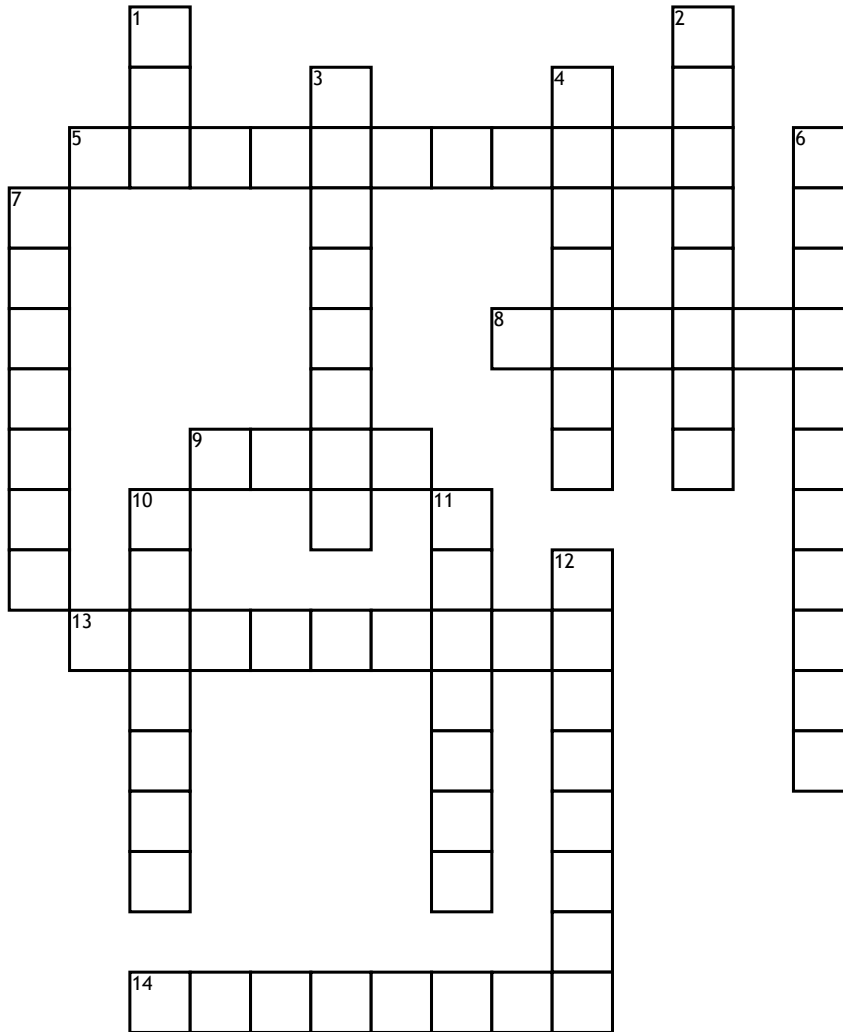

11. (noun) A person who reigns over a kingdom or empire: a king or queen
