
Group 5 Crossword Puzzle Review

- 2. A generalized (sometimes accurate but often overgeneralized) belief about a group of people
- **3.** The situation or the person's disposition
- **6.** Social facilitation, improved performance on simple or well learned tasks in the presence of others
- 7. The mode of thinking that occurs when the desire for harmony in a decision-making group overrides a realistic appraisal of alternatives
- 10. The existence of unequal opportunities and rewards for different social positions or statuses within a group or society. This often leads to the development of attitudes that justify the status quo
- **18.** The enhancement of a group's prevailing inclinations through discussion within the group
- **19.** Influence resulting from a person's desire to gain approval or avoid
- **21.** The unawareness of how attitudes are influencing our behavior IMPLICIT

- **22.** An unjustifiable (and usually negative) attitude towards a group and its members
- **23.** Occurs when people are influenced by incidental cues, such as a speaker's attractiveness
- **24.** The tendency for people who have first agreed to a small request to comply later with a larger request
- **25.** The theory that we act to reduce the discomfort (dissonance) we feel when two of our thoughts (cognitions) are inconsistent

- 1. Occurs when interested people focus on the arguments and respond with favorable thoughts
- **4.** Expectation that people should help those who depend on them
- **5.** The tendency for people in a group to exert less effort when pooling their efforts toward attaining a common goal than when individually accountable
- **8.** A small minority that consistently expresses its views may sway the majority

- **9.** The loss of self-awareness and self-restraint occuring in group situations that foster arousal and anonymity
- **11.** Social expectation that prescribes how we should behave. SOCIALIZATION
- 12. Conflicting parties by each pursuing their self interest become caught in mutually destructive behavior
- 13. Feelings often influenced by beliefs which predispose people to have specific reactions to objects, people, and events
- **14.** A conscious and deliberate attitude EXPLICIT
- **15.** Prejudice offers by providing someone to blame
- **16.** Expectation that people will respond favorably to each other by returning benefits for benefit RECIPROCITY
- **17.** Unjustifiable negative behavior towards a group and its members
