

## Hair Sculpture



## **Across**

- 2. This comb is used to sculpt close to the scalp
- **5.** Protruding bone located below the crest area in the back of the head
- **10.** Produces tapering or an angle effect on the end of each 1. This comb controls larger strand
- 11. Area below the occipital area

- 12. This produces a clean, blunt edge
- **13.** Widest Area of the head
- 14. Produces a distinct and regular alternation of shorter and longer lengths

## <u>Down</u>

- amounts of hair
- 3. Top/Highest point of the head
- 4. This comb detangles hair

- **6.** This comb is used to distribute hair
- 7. Electric implement that creates clean, precise lines to soft, broom-like effects
- **8.** Upright or tilted forward are examples of what?
- **9.** Area in the upper back and on tops of the crest area, begins where the tops of the head begins to curve downward
