

Haircolor

1. Gradual haircolor containing metal salts
 2. The strength of a color
 3. system of understanding color relationships
 4. aka oxidizing agents or catalysts
 5. the unit of measurement used to identify the lightness or darkness of a color
 6. part of the hair shaft between the scalp and the hair that has been previously colored
 7. aka undertones
 8. no lift, deposit only color that needs to be mixed with a catalyst
 9. measures the concentration and strength of hydrogen peroxide
 10. the balance of color, aka hue
 11. aka predisposition test
 12. determines how the hair will react to formula and how long to process hair
 13. process that lightens and deposits in one application
 14. lightens and deposits color at the same time in one process
 15. first step of a double-process haircoloring service
