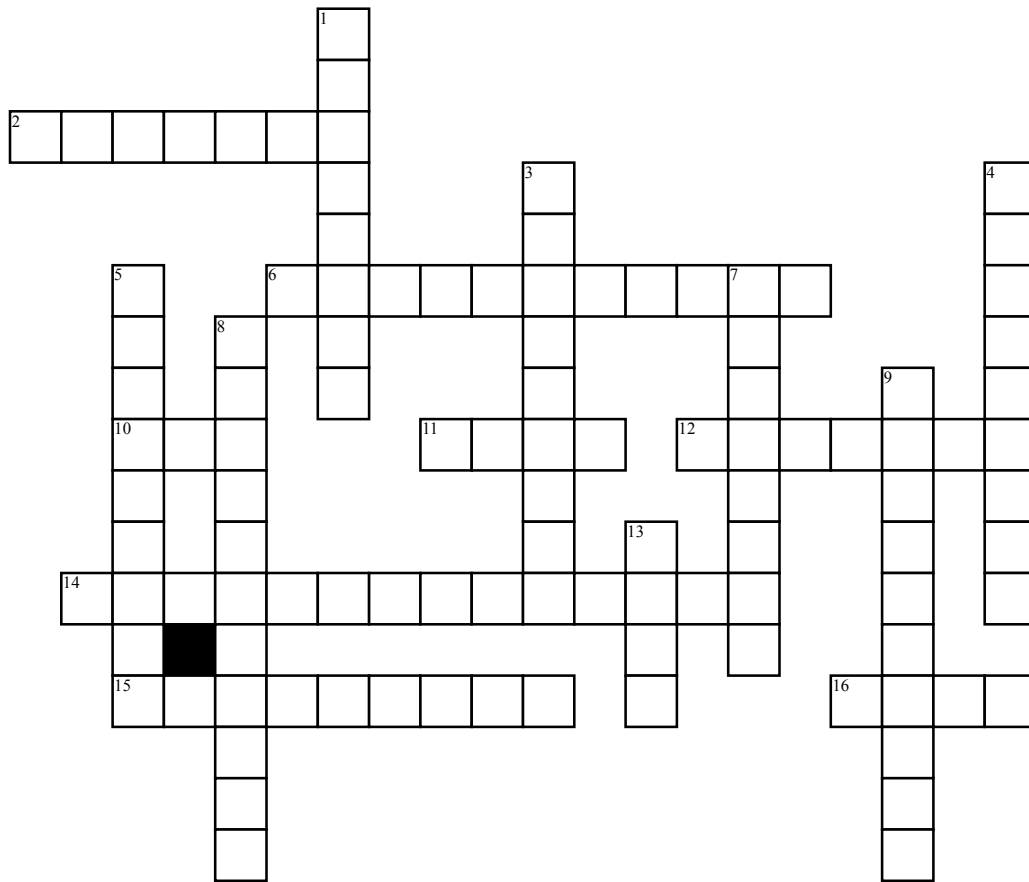


Harmful Substances Advocacy Crossword
