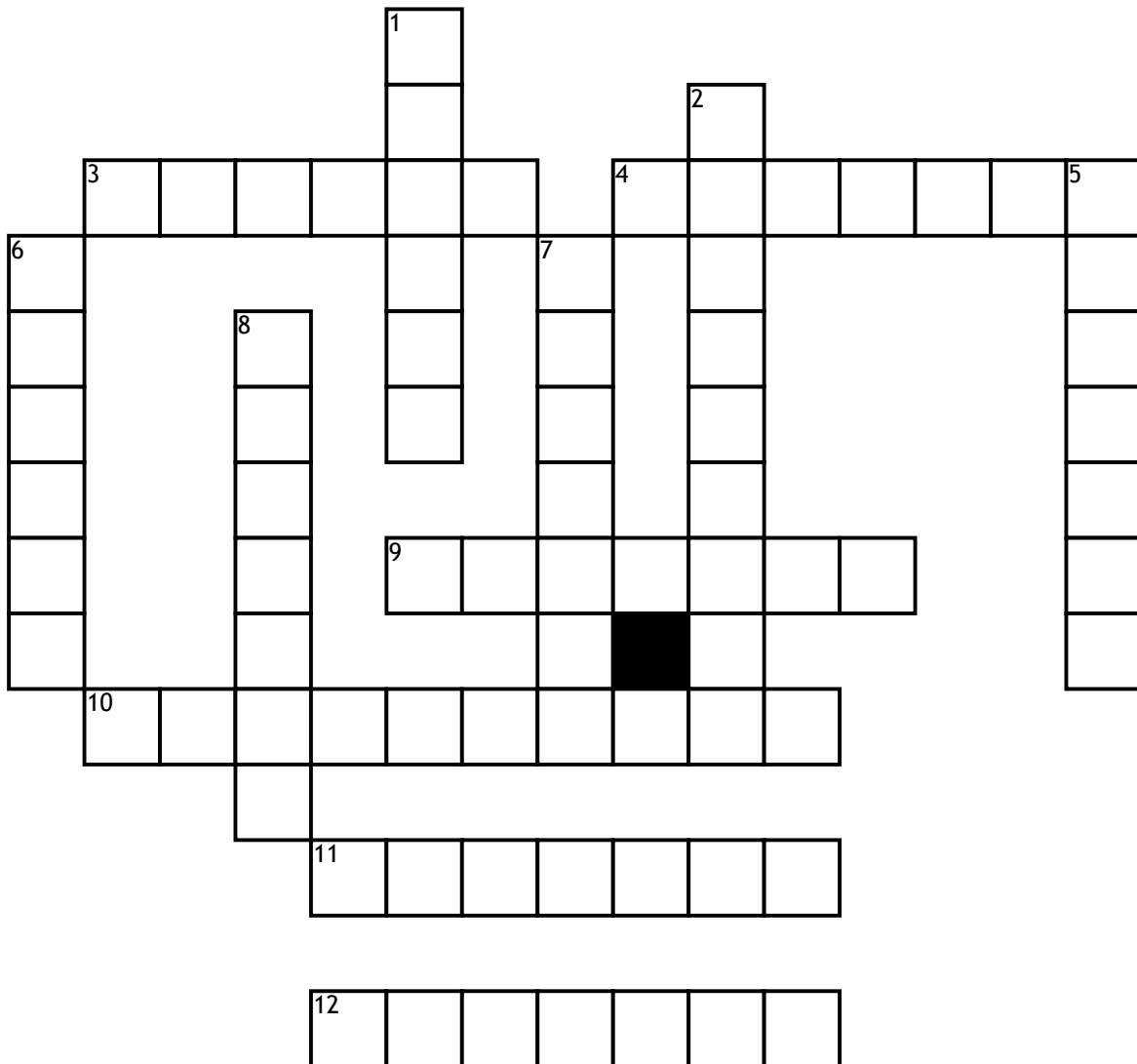


Hayden's Crossword Puzzle
