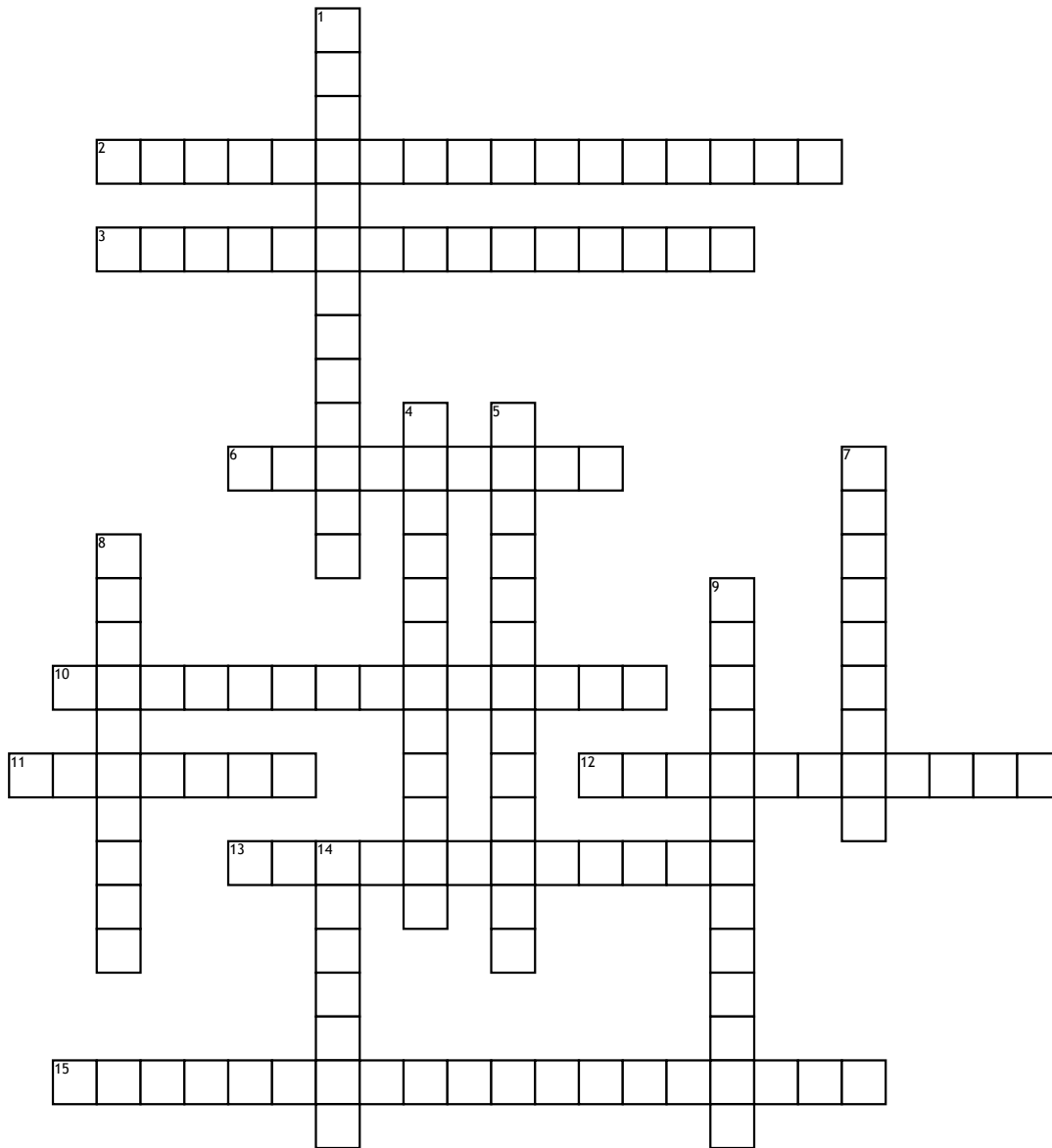


Head and Neck Anatomy



Across

- 2. behind lower molars on mandibular ramus
- 3. veins superficial to sternocleidomastoid muscle
- 6. notch between base of tongue and epiglottis
- 10. where teeth fit in
- 11. division of larynx containing true vocal cords
- 12. area outside the larynx tube

- 13. division of larynx including the epiglottis, false cords, arytenoid cartilage, and aryepiglottic folds

- 15. nodes that lie superficial to sternocleidomastoid muscle

Down

- 1. salivary gland that drains through wharton's duct
- 4. primary lymphatic drainage in head and neck

- 5. nodes that drain cheek, side of nose, upper and lateral lip, and gums

- 7. nodes that drain lower lip, floor of mouth, and anterior tongue

- 8. anterior to circumvallate papillae

- 9. right sided artery that originates from brachiocephalic artery

- 14. salivary gland that drains through stenson's duct
