

**6.** unit of measurement that schools use to determine whether students are progressing toward graduation

7. methods of paying for education/training, such as grants, scholarships, etc.

8. learning on the job

10. a certificate of completion awarded to a person after completing a program of study in a particular area, usually lasting 2 years

 a document stating that a person has passed a five-part test in the areas of writing, social studies, science, reading, and math
 a temporary pair or unpaid position that involves direct work experience in a career field
 a program of study beyond a bachelor's degree

**4.** a certificate of completion awarded to a person after successfully completing a required set of college courses in both general and specific areas

**5.** a program in which a person learns to do a certain job by working with a skilled worker
