

- 7. This major reform movement sought to end slavery in America, was very popular among the Transcendentalism movement
- **8.** This individual created the written Cherokee language
- 10. Created by tribe leader John Ross, created a government form for the Cherokee nation that resembled that of the US
- 11. Chief justice in the US supreme court that sided with the Cherokee Nation

- **12.** Father, wealthy Cherokee leader, wanted to take the governments deal and move west
- 13. A few self-appointed individuals of the Cherokee nation made this treaty in 1835 with the US government to sell their land and move west

1. Emergency session that John Ross held to rally support for the nation to stay in their land

- 2. This US president signed the Indian Removal Act but vetoed the renewal of the US bank
