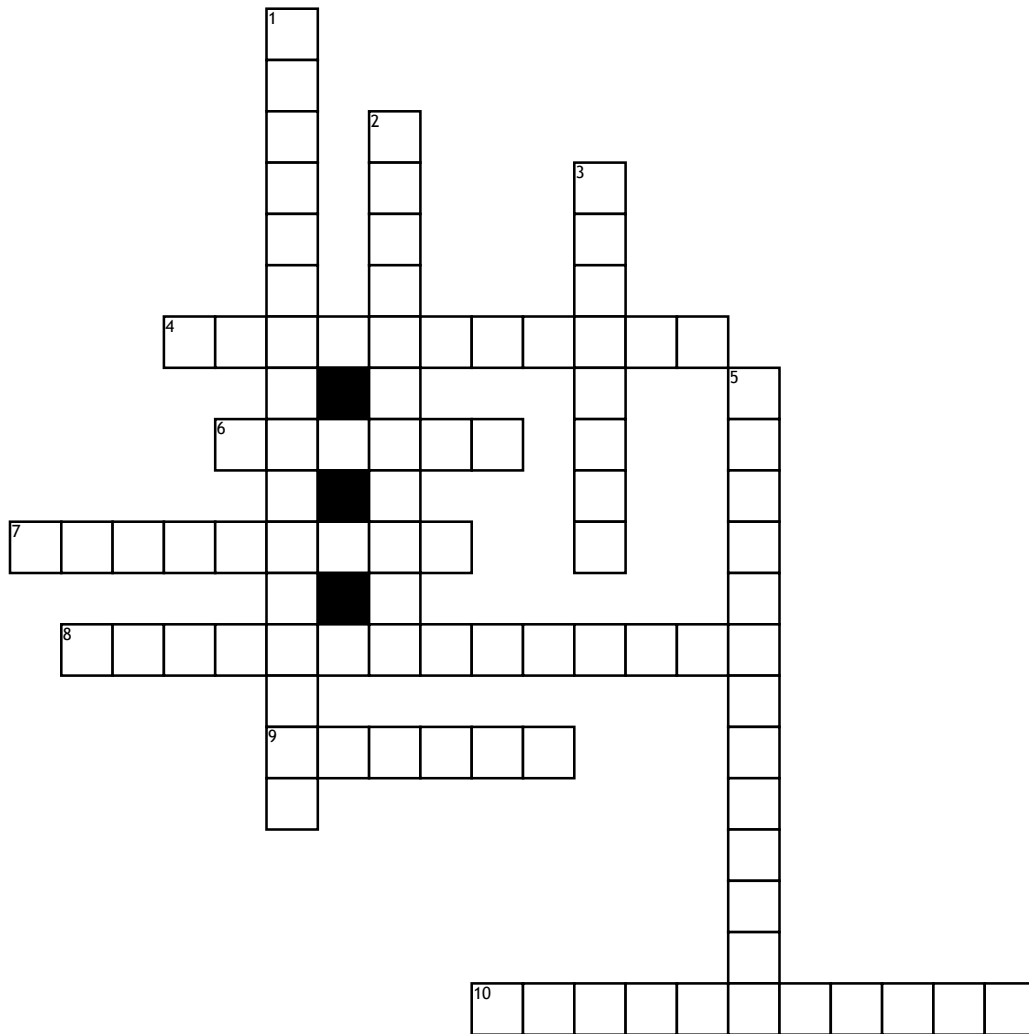


# History Africa Crossword Puzzle
