

- 9. A law enacted in 1854 that established the territories of Kansas and Nebraska and gave their residents the right to decide weather to allow slavery or not
- **10.** The idea, expressed by Stephen doubles in 1858, that any territory could exclude slavery by simply refusing to pass laws supporting it
