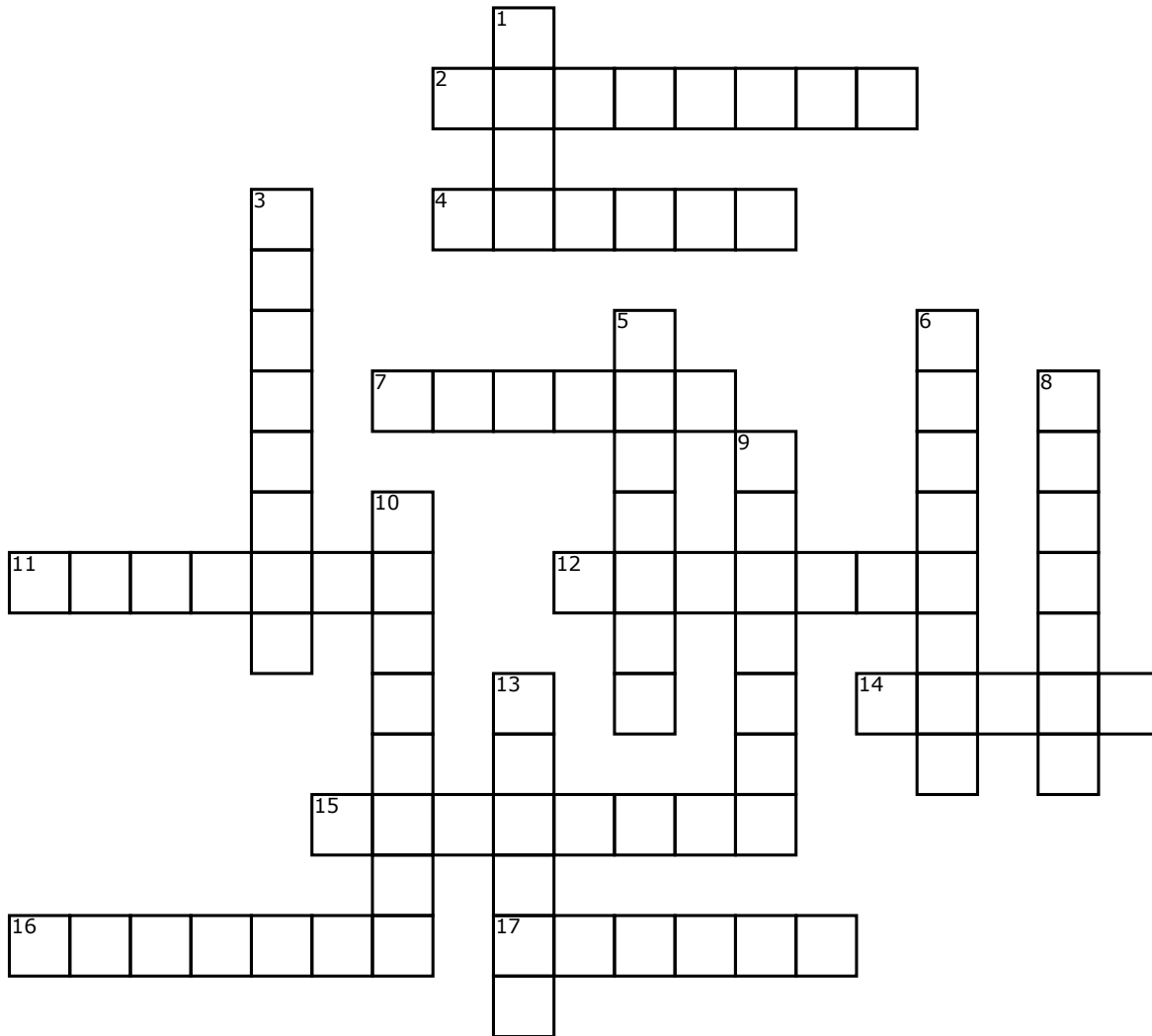

1. A player who has little other purpose on the ice than to try and get players to fight.

3. Hitting the puck with the blade of the stick after taking a full backswing.

6. When one player makes three or more goals in one game.

8. The line that divides the rink into two equal parts. This area is center ice.

9. The drop of the puck between one player from each team to resume play.

10. The open space between goalie's leg.

13. When one or more players touch the puck before the goal, no interference from defenders.
