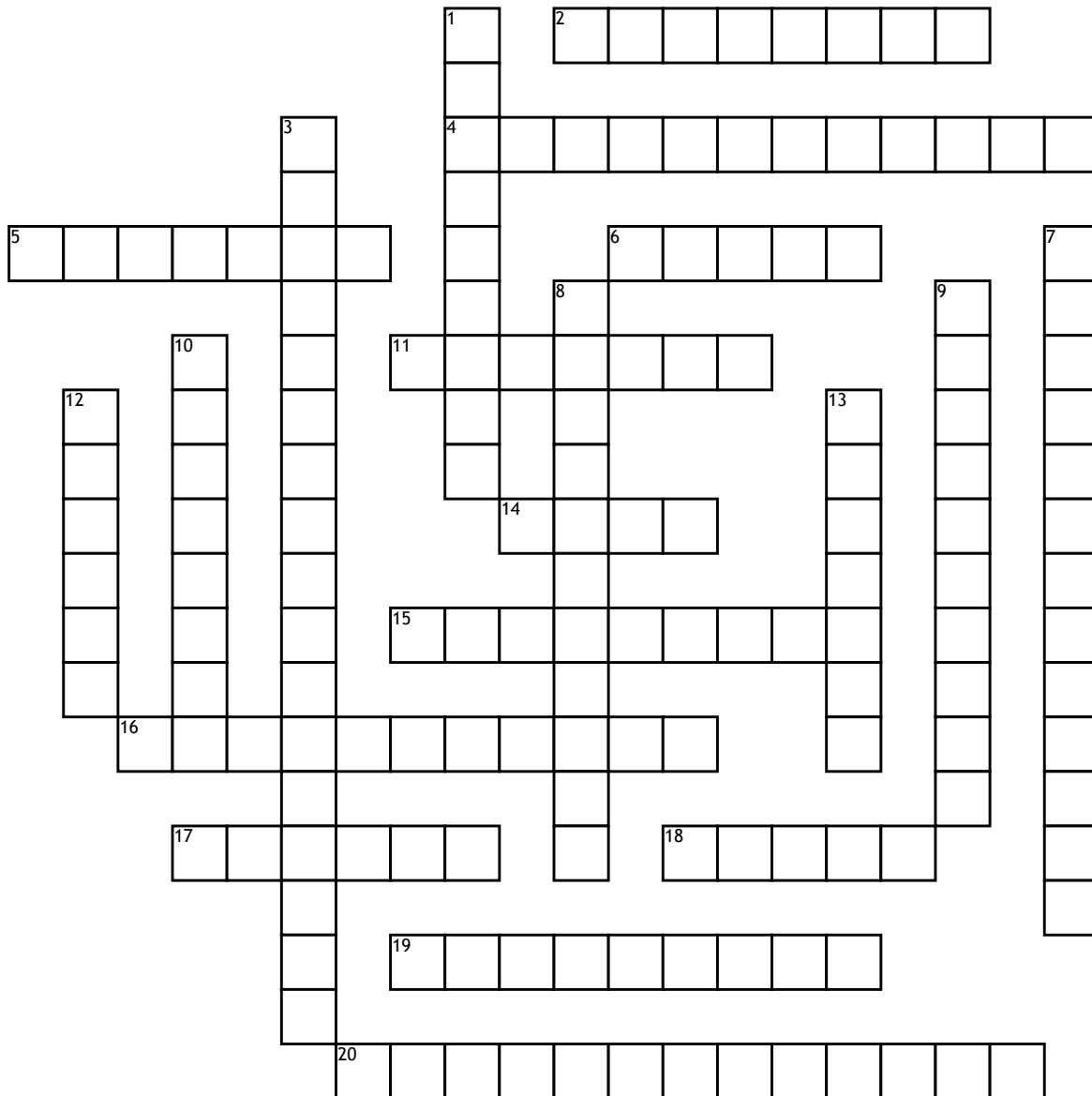

2. Symbol of the Nazi party; originally an ancient religious symbol.  
 4. Discrimination or persecution of Jews.  
 5. The gas used to kill Jews in the gas chambers at the death camps.  
 6. Racial term used by Nazis to describe a "race" they believed to be superior. It has no biological validity.  
 11. Organized acts of persecution or massacre of a specific group of people.  
 14. Acronym for National Socialist German Workers Party.  
 15. Term used to refer to the systematic killing of 6 million Jews by the Nazis between 1933 and 1945. Also included extermination of Gypsies and Poles.

16. The forced removal of Jews in Nazi occupied lands to concentration camps.  
 17. Practice of discrimination and persecution on the basis of race.  
 18. German for "Jews"  
 19. An attitude toward a person or group of people formed without adequate information.  
 20. "Night of Broken Glass." Nazi organized riot against the Jews on Nov. 9-10, 1938.
