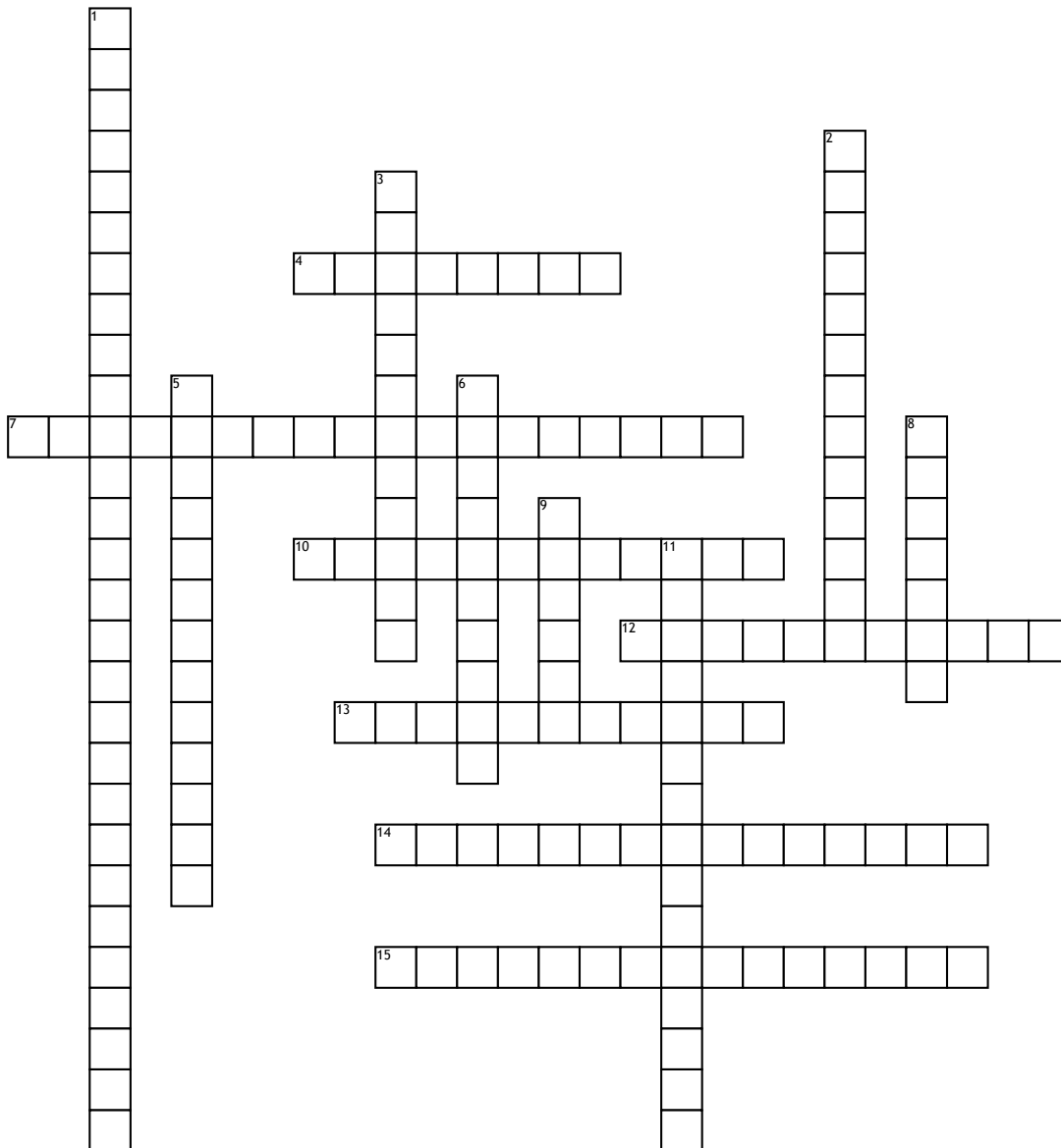

1. A situation in which quantity demanded equals quantity supplied

2. A change in price does affect the quantity demanded

3. Amount of a good/service produced in a given time period

9. Amount of particular good or service consumers want to buy

11. Change in price doesn't affect quantity demanded- hard to produce more
