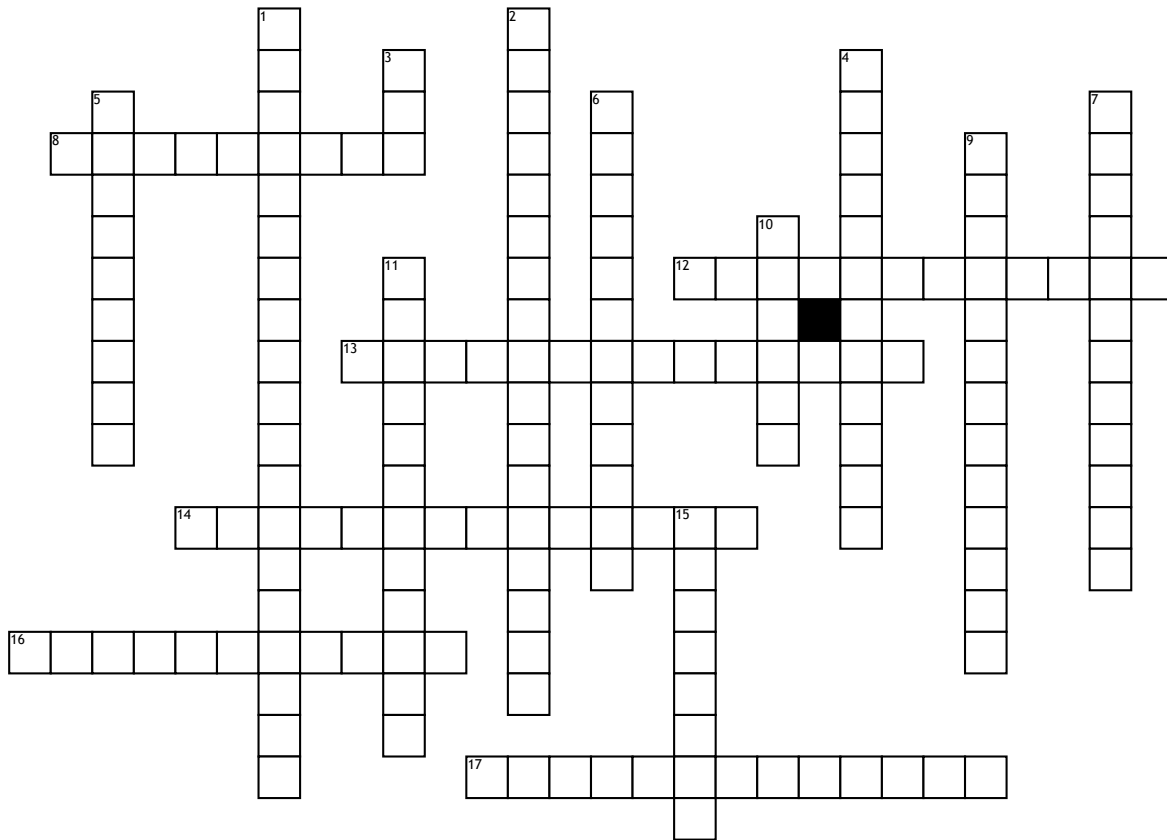

 13. abnormal cell growth in the prostate gland. It can be slow growing or fast growing.

 17. When the endometrium backs up into the fallopian tubes instead of being released to the outside of the body

1. surgical removal of the uterus, cervix, ovaries, and fallopian tubes.
 2. surgical removal of the uterus and cervix
 3. a condition that occurs 7-10 days before the menstrual period begins.
 4. a hormone of the ovary that prepares the uterus to receive the fertilized ovum.
 5. male sterilization operation performed under local anesthesia. It involves cutting the vas deferens

6. male sex hormone manufactured in the testicles. It is responsible for puberty and sperm cell production
 7. surgical procedure in which the uterus is completely removed.
 9. the tying or binding of the fallopian tubes as a method of sterilization.
 10. when part of the intestine protrudes down the inguinal canal into the scrotum.
 11. to cut off the foreskin of the penis
 15. a hormone that promotes development of various female characteristics
